# Identity Theft / Identity Fraud Let's Not Become a Victim

What is Identity Theft?

The basic definition of identity theft and identity fraud is: Identity theft refers to the preparatory stage of acquiring and collecting someone else's personal information for criminal purposes. Identity fraud is the actual deceptive use of the identity information of another person (living or dead) in connection with various frauds (including for example; impersonating another person and the misuse of debit card or credit card data).

As of January 8, 2010, Senate Bill S-4 became law, making it illegal to possess another person's identity information for criminal purposes.

Some of the Facts:

- Identity theft techniques can range from the unsophisticated, such as dumpster diving and mail theft, to more elaborate schemes using the internet.
- Technology, mainly the Internet, facilitates more elaborate schemes, such as skimming, phishing, and hacking as criminals gather profiles of potential victims. Computer spywares and viruses, designed to help thieves acquire personal information, are an emerging trend. You can be infected through an unknown downloaded program or opening and responding to an unsuspecting email.
- Victims of identity theft or fraud can experience financial loss and difficulty obtaining credit or restoring their "good name".

Identity thieves are looking for the following information: Full name, date of birth, Social Insurance Numbers

(SIN number), full address, mother's maiden name, username and password for online services, driver's license number, personal identification numbers (PIN), credit card information (numbers, expiry dates and the last three digits printed on the signature panel), bank account numbers, signature, Birth Certificate, and passport number. Any number or combination of these identifications can result in your identity being compromised and cause hardship for you and your family.

What your information could be used for:

Criminals can use your stolen or reproduced personal or financial information to:

- access your bank accounts to steal your money
- open new bank accounts to apply for loans under your identity
- transfer bank balances from your account to an account either, opened in your name or another account that is under control of an identity thief
- apply for loans, credit cards and other goods and services under your name
- make purchases using your credit cards and money
- hide their criminal activities under your name and identity
- obtain passports or receive government benefits while impersonating you





# Let's Talk - Everyday

**BELL - Let's Talk – Mental Health Awareness Day January 31** - Many people living with a mental illness report that negative stereotypes about mental illness, and the resulting potential for discrimination, causes them more suffering than the illness itself. As a result, two thirds of those suffering from mental illness are too afraid to seek the help that they need.

Mental illness affects people of all ages and from all walks of life. It can take many forms, including depression, anxiety and schizophrenia. Most individuals find ways to live with their illnesses but how they are treated by others often proves to be more of a challenge than the illness itself. We invite you to join the conversation around mental health on Bell Let's Talk Day, January 31. Stigma surrounded many diseases in the past, but concerted efforts to confront these attitudes resulted in change for the better, including better treatment, more funding for research, and greater understanding from family, friends and colleagues. The goal is to achieve the same level of acceptance and understanding regarding mental illness.

On Bell Let's Talk Day, for every text, mobile and long distance call made on the Bell network, tweet using #BellLetsTalk, social media video view, or use of the Facebook or Snapchat filter, Bell will contribute 5 cents more to Canadian mental health programs.

Be Kind -Simple kindness can make a world of difference. Whether it be a smile, being a good listener or an invitation for coffee and a chat, these simple acts of kindness can help open up the conversation and let someone know you are there for them.

Expressions like "You'll get over it" and "Just relax" can minimize how a person is feeling. Instead offer your support and say "I'm sorry you aren't feeling well." Ask what you can do to help.

Listen and ask - Mental illness is a very common form of human pain and suffering. Being a good listener and asking how you can help, sometimes just even being there for people you care about, can be the first step in recovery.

Here are a few examples of what to ask:

- I'm sorry you aren't feeling well.
- I've noticed you've seemed down lately.
- Is everything ok?
  - How can I help?

Talk about it - Break the silence. Mental illness touches us all in some way directly or through a friend, family member or colleague. Stories of people who have experienced mental health issues and who are doing well can really challenge stereotypes. Most people with mental health issues can and do recover, just by talking about it.

# What every woman should know about heart disease

Understand your risk and how to protect yourself

If you're like most women, you know that heart disease is serious. But you may not think it matters to you. Consider these facts:

Heart disease is the leading cause of premature death for women in Canada (dying before reaching their expected lifespan). Five times as many women die from heart disease as breast cancer. Women who have a heart attack are more likely to die or suffer a second heart attack compared to men. Women's hearts are different from men's in ways that are just beginning to be understood, says Dr. Cindy Yip, director of heart health at Heart & Stroke. Women are under-aware and under-researched when it comes to heart disease, she says. Within the healthcare system they are under-diagnosed and under-treated, and under-supported in their recovery. The time to act is now, and the solutions will require system-wide changes.

The Heart & Stroke 2018 Heart Report takes a hard look at these "unders" — how we got here, and how we can work together to close the gaps that put too many women at risk. The risks are even higher for Indigenous and ethnically diverse women, those living in poverty and women in remote and rural areas.

"Women in Canada still work a disproportionate number of unpaid hours, often leaving them little time to take care of their own health," says Dr. Yip. "We need to better support women so that they fully and deeply understand that taking care of others begins with taking care of themselves, and that self-care should not be one more thing added to an already overfull plate. It should be something that their families, workplaces and healthcare providers understand and support."

Meanwhile, there are things women can do to reduce their risk of heart disease. It starts with talking to your doctor about your individual risk factors. Plus, these lifestyle changes can help reduce your risk:

· becoming and remaining smoke free

Taking control

- achieving and maintaining a healthy body weight
- being physically active for at least 150 minutes of moderate- to vigorous-intensity aerobic physical activity per week, in bouts of 10 minutes or more
- maintaining a healthy blood pressure through lifestyle changes (such as increased physical activity) and when needed through medication
- eating a healthy, balanced diet focused on whole foods with lots of vegetables and fruit, and cooking at home as often as possible
- using medications to reduce the risk of heart disease and stroke as prescribed by your healthcare pro-

vider, for example medications for high blood pressure, high blood cholesterol and diabetes.

Good news

The 2018 Heart Report shares examples of exciting research underway that will help us better understand the unique risks women face.

For example, studies funded by Heart & Stroke donors will enhance understanding of:

spontaneous coronary artery dissection (SCAD), the underlying cause of more than 25% of all heart attacks in women under 60, how pregnancy affects women's heart health, and ways to reduce risk

the link between breast cancer treatment and heart disease.

"For too long women's hearts have been misunderstood," says Dr. Yip. "We must change that, and we'll only succeed by working together — governments, healthcare providers, researchers, funders and more."

"Meanwhile women can help themselves by being aware, knowing what questions to ask their healthcare providers, being part of research breakthroughs, and taking time to take care of their health," she says.

"We, including myself, need to remember the best way to take care of others is to take care of ourselves first!"

How can you find out if your identity was stolen? The best way to find out is to monitor your hard copy or on-line financial accounts frequently and to check your credit report regularly for any unusual activities. If you receive calls from collection agencies about unfamiliar accounts, or if you applied for credit and were unexpectedly turned down, you should investigate further.

## Report it

If you suspect or know that you are a victim of identity theft or fraud, or if you unwittingly provided personal information or financial information:

- Step 1 Contact your local police force (RCMP or EPS) and file a report.
- Step 2 Contact your bank/financial institution and Credit Card Company.
- Step 3 Contact the two national credit bureaus and place a fraud alert on your credit reports.
  - o Equifax Canada at Toll free: 1-800-465-7166
- o TransUnion Canada at Toll free: 1-877-525-3823
- Step 4 Always report identity theft and fraud. Contact the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre at 1-888-495-8501 Service Canada at 1-800-206-7218 (If your SIN card has been compromised)
- Prevention is the best way to deal with this crime:
- Identity theft can occur over the Internet (email) or telephone, via fax or regular mail. Therefore, be particularly wary of unsolicited e-mails, telephone calls or mail attempting to extract personal or financial information from you. If an email or phone call asks you to log into your online account or give the numbers to your account over the phone, BEWARE, this is a common tactic to extract valuable information used to steal your identity.
- Ask yourself if you really need all of the identity documents you carry in your wallet or purse. Remove any you don't need and keep them in a secure place instead.
- Periodically check your credit reports, bank and credit card statements and report any irregularities promptly to the relevant financial institution and to the credit bureaus.
  - During transactions, it's safer to swipe your

cards yourself than it is to allow a cashier to do it for you. If you must hand over your card, never lose sight of it.

- Always shield your personal identification number when using an ATM or a PIN pad.
- Memorize all personal identification numbers for payment cards and telephone calling cards. Never write them on the cards.
- Familiarize yourself with billing cycles for your credit and debit cards.
- Trash bins are a goldmine for identity thieves. Make sure you shred personal and financial documents before putting them in the garbage. This includes ATM slips or receipts
- Cut up expired and unused cards credit / ATM cards.
- When you change your address, make sure you notify the post office and all relevant financial institutions (your bank and credit card companies).
- Don't fill in forms that ask for more information then you feel is necessary.
- Beware of social media sites that ask for information that could put you at risk. Do not post personal information on social media sites as these sites are checked regularly for potential targets of "identity theft" thieves.





# warns about caller advising breast self-exam

January 26, 2018

Alberta Health Services (AHS) is working with the RCMP to warn women in northern Alberta to be aware of misleading telephone calls regarding breast cancer results.

As of January 25, AHS received reports of a man calling two women, one in Barrhead and one in Slave Lake, claiming to be from a medical imaging facility. The caller relayed breast exam results and implied that routine follow-up required the women to immediately perform a breast self-exam while on the phone. The caller also asked for personal information.

AHS and RCMP were informed of similar calls of this nature, in the summer of 2017. AHS issued a PSA at that time and no further incidents were reported until one phone call on January 21, 2018 and a second on January 25, 2018.

Although AHS representatives may call to discuss mammography details, they will never ask a patient to conduct a breast self-exam over the phone.

If you receive a phone call of this nature, please hang

up, note the time and any other call details and do the following:

Immediately after you hang up with the caller, pick up the phone again, wait for the dial tone, then press "\*" then "5" then "7". Wait for a voice recording to tell you that the call has been traced then hang up. "\*57" will create a trace of the previous call that the police or RCMP can access later. After completing the above \*57 steps, hang up again, and immediately contact local police or RCMP on their non-emergency line. Be sure to inform them you dialed \*57 after the call of concern. If you are uncomfortable with calling police directly or are uncertain whether the call is legitimate, you can call AHS' Screening Program Client Support Line at 1-866-727-3926.

An AHS privacy investigation is underway. As it is an active and ongoing investigation we cannot comment further.

AHS and RCMP encourage anyone who has experienced this issue to please call your local police or RCMP.






