



Mini Mac-and-Cheese Cakes Recipe (Gluten Free)

Here is a recipe the whole family will love. It makes a great appetizer or a main course.

Total Time

50 min

Prep Time 25 min

Servings 12

Ingredients

- 1 cup (250 mL) uncooked gluten-free elbow macaroni
- 3 cups (750 mL) Rice Chex* cereal, finely crushed
- 21/2 cups (625 mL) shredded Cheddar cheese
- 5 tbsp (75 mL) unsalted butter, melted, divided
- 1 tbsp (15 mL) gluten-free flour blend
- 1 cup (250 mL) whole milk, warmed
- 1 egg yolk, slightly beaten
- 1/4 tsp (1 mL) salt
- 1 egg white, beaten until stiff but not dry

- Cook and drain macaroni as directed on package.
- Move oven rack to lower third of oven. Heat oven to 350°F. Lightly grease 12 regular-size muffin cups.
- In medium bowl, mix crushed cereal, 1 cup of the cheese and 4 tablespoons of the melted butter. Divide mixture among muffin cups; press firmly in bottom and up sides of cups with spoon.
- In 3-quart saucepan, stir together remaining 1 tablespoon melted butter and flour blend with whisk; cook over medium heat 1 minute. Gradually stir in warmed milk with whisk; cook and stir about 5 minutes or until thickened. Remove from heat; stir in 1 cup of the cheese until melted. Stir in cooked macaroni, egg yolk and salt. Fold in beaten egg white. Spoon about 1/4 cup mixture into each crustlined cup. Top with remaining 1/2 cup cheese.
- Bake about 20 minutes or until golden and puffed. Cool 5 minutes; remove from pan. Serve warm.

Recovery of Stolen Vehicle by the Central Alberta District Integrated Crime Reduction Unit

On November 1, after observing suspicious activity, the Integrated Crime Reduction Unit (ICRU) effected the safe arrest of a male driving a stolen vehicle.

In the early evening, the ICRU were patrolling in Calmar when they spotted a suspicious male. Investigation revealed that the vehicle he was operating was reported stolen out of Leduc on October 31, 2017. It was established that the male was breaching court order conditions as well. ICRU members waited until they had an opportunity to make an arrest safely. At approximately 10:00 p.m., with no disruption to anyone in the public the male suspect was taken into custody with the assistance of the Leduc RCMP and Police Dog Services.

33-year-old Dustin James Funk has been charged with the following criminal charges:

- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5,000
- Possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose
- Resist arrest
- Possession of a controlled substance (x2) Controlled Drugs and Substances Act
- Fail to comply with conditions of a Recognizance (x2)

Funk is currently in police custody awaiting a judicial interim release.

The stolen vehicle was recovered by the RCMP and returned to the rightful owner.

The ICRU is a recently formed RCMP team whose mandate is to identify high risk and dangerous prolific offenders in Alberta and aggressively put a stop to their activities. Property crimes are a priority for the RCMP. This ICRU is committed to increased inter-agency communication, shared criminal intelligence and a strategic focus on prolific property crimes offenders, in keeping with the K Division emphasis on crime reduction strategies.


