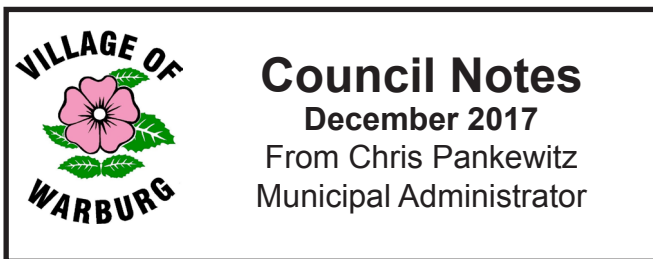

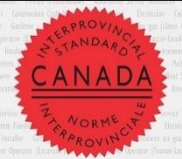

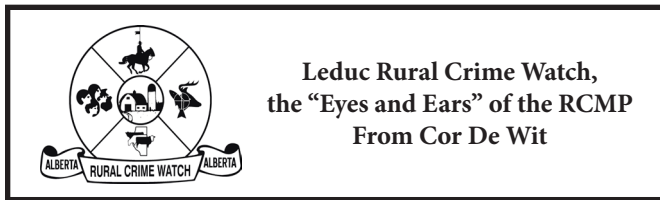

"Telemarketing Fraud, those annoying phone calls"

Telemarketing Fraud can happen to anyone. Your family, friends and neighbors, can become victims of Telemarketing Fraud. It is not isolated to urban or rural folks. It can affect individuals, companies and even levels of government.

Telemarketing Fraud is often not reported because of the embarrassment and shame of becoming a victim. That is exactly what the criminals want. If the crime is never reported, no investigation and arrest can take place to stop these criminals. The sooner a Telemarketing Fraud Scheme is reported to police, the sooner the criminal can be stopped and arrested.

Be Aware;

- Don't believe everyone who calls (or emails) with an exciting promotion or great investment opportunity.
- Don't disclose personal information about your bank accounts, credit cards, addresses, etc. over the phone.
- Don't be afraid to hang up.
- Don't be afraid to ask for documentation to verify a product or investment. But remember; even the best criminals have brochures, literature, fake websites and folders full of false information.
- Do take the opportunity to ask the caller about their offer or promotion, if you are interested. Do ask for references from other customers who live in your area. No legitimate company will refuse to answer your questions.
- Don't be pressured into making a decision. Any real gift or prize will still be available tomorrow after you have had a chance to research the offer.
- Do take the time to call a friend, relative, banker or investment advisor, or a police agency (RCMP, EPS) before making a decision. Even the Better Business Bureau (BBB) can be a wealth of information regarding an offer from a "fake" company. The BBB rates most companies on their performance and these ratings are publicly accessible.
- When using the internet to search for various products, you may become a victim of "adware". If you are asked to send money to have your computer unlocked, do not send money. Take your computer to an authorized service technician, and have your

computer properly restored to its original condition.

Be on the guard for the following offers;

- "You won a car, but money is required up front for taxes, shipping, insurance etc."
- "You won cash, but must pre pay the taxes, broker age fees etc., before money can be sent"
- "You won a prize, but in order to claim it, you must purchase another product" (usually of poor quality and over priced).
- "You owe money to the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) for back taxes and if you do not pay immediately they will be forced to issue an arrest warrant". This is a fake attempt to extort money for you. The CRA does not use these types of tactics to recover any taxes.

Don't fall for these scams; they are designed to take advantage of your good nature and take advantage of the human instinct to get something for "free".

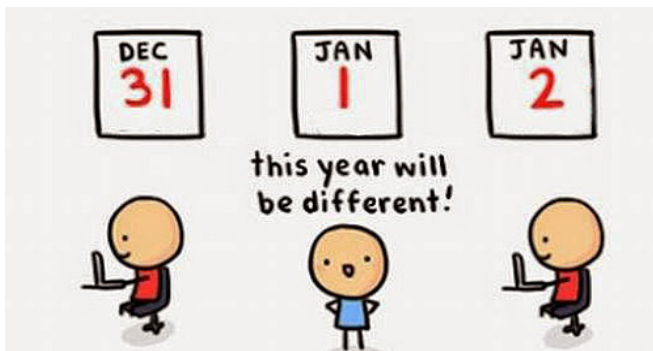
