

Check Your Mailboxes

From Alberta RCMP

The newly operating Call Back Unit in the RCMP KDivision headquarters building is reporting that several calls have been received in relation to rural mailboxes which have been the target of thefts. While there is no one community that these thefts are associated with – citizens across the province are being reminded to check on their mailboxes daily.

Criminals who steal mail are targeting pre-paid credit cards, gift cards, cheques and documents that will make it easy for them to access your banking and other personal information. This time of year, thieves are especially targeting the pre-paid credit cards used by tax companies to deliver tax refunds to their clients, or refunds otherwise directly distributed.

RCMP urge citizens in the province to take steps every day to protect themselves from mailbox theft, and ultimately, identity theft:

- Check your mailbox daily and remove the accumulated mail.
- If you are expecting a parcel consider having that parcel sent either registered mail, or to a business address where someone can accept the delivery.
- Consider picking up your on-line purchases at the stores you ordered from.

If your mailbox has been broken into, or tampered with, call your local RCMP Detachment and report the situation to Canada Post. If you believe that mail has been stolen from your mailbox:

 Contact the business or agency who you were expecting mail from including utility companies, banking organizations and credit card companies.
 This type of mail contains information that may lead to identity theft.

If you observe suspicious activity in progress at a mailbox, call your local RCMP Detachment. If you wish to remain anonymous, call Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-8477 or report it online at www.tipsubmit.com. If your information leads to an arrest, you could be eligible for a cash reward up to \$2,000.

New Bilateral Agreement for Alberta Infrastructure

Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to inform residents that the Government of Canada and Government of Alberta have signed a new bilateral agreement that will provide more than \$3.3 billion over the next ten years for infrastructure projects in the province.

These projects will be cost-shared with the Alberta government, municipalities and other partners. The funding will be invested in public transit, green infrastructure, recreational cultural, and community infrastructure, as well as rural and northern communities.

"This builds on a previous announcement that the federal cost share for infrastructure projects through the Investing in Canada plan will increase from 50% to 60% for rural and northern communities," stated MP Eglinski. "This will help lessen the financial burden on these communities and increase their access to infrastructure funds."

The announced agreement builds on Alberta's 2018 Capital Plan, which commits \$26.6 billion over five years to support priority infrastructure projects across the province. The announcement is also part of a series of federal-provincial agreements to invest in infrastructure across the country. Provinces are expected to develop three-year plans that will outline how they will implement their infrastructure projects.

"It is paramount that the Alberta Government ensures a sizable portion of this funding is made available to projects in rural and remote municipalities. This will help our communities create economic growth and remain competitive while investing in projects such as broadband, water, and road infrastructure," concluded MP Eglinski.



Leduc Rural Crime Watch, the "Eyes and Ears" of the RCMP From Cor De Wit

"Crime prevention and Baby Sitting - what do they have in common?"

As a resident, we look for ways to be vigilant in crime prevention. It may be more outdoor lights, gates and barriers or even security systems that can be placed in areas around your home or business. But one area that seems to be overlooked is when you are away and your home and your children are in the trust of an older child or babysitter.

The following article contains tips and suggestions that you may wish to add to your information list that is left at home during your outing or simply if you are away from home. The baby sitter is looking after your most valued possession; it is your job to give the baby sitter the "tools" to get the job done effectively.

Precautions that should be taken while babysitting:

- Check all windows and lock all doors, turning the outside lights on after dark.
- Do not allow anyone into the home without prior permission from your employer, or parent.
- · Closing the blinds and drawing the shades.
- Never admit on the telephone or at the door that you are the babysitter and are home alone.
- If someone is at the door: Use the peephole, or talk through the door, to see who is there. Never open the door and never tell anyone you are babysitting. Yell through the door, "My mom (or dad) is busy, come back later!" You can also offer to take a message. If the person will not leave, call 9-1-1.
- If someone calls: Say, "My mom (or dad) is busy, please call back later." Take a message and tell the caller that the person will call them back. Hang up if the caller becomes a nuisance and call the police if you feel threatened.
- If they hear suspicious noises or activity: Call the police.
- If there is an emergency: Call 9-1-1.

What to do in case of fire:

- If there is a fire: Never attempt to put out the fire.
 Remain calm and leave the house immediately.
 Call 9-1-1 from a neighbor's house.
- Do not re-enter the home.
- Keep a close watch on the children so that they do not try and re-enter the home or get in the way of emergency personnel.
- Contact the home owner.

Guarding against accidents:

- Pick up toys left on the stairs, in hall or other pathways.
- Be alert to possible child hazards. Look for medicines in bathroom, dangerous utensils in kitchen, do not let children play with the electrical outlets.
- Check frequently, on children, while they are playing away from your site line.
- Do not operate appliances or equipment, unless permission was given by the parents.

How to be safe on the street with children:

- Babysitters should never take the children into someone else's home or vehicle, unless permission was granted by the children's parents.
- Babysitters should not take the children to secluded parks, woods, parking lots, or school yards particularly late afternoon or evening.
- Precautions should be taken when attending after school activities with children under your care.
- If babysitters need to travel, they should plan the best route with their employer, avoiding unsafe or dangerous places
- They should stay on that route and identify the neighborhood safe houses, businesses, or stores that they can go to in an emergency.
- Babysitters should always listen to their instinct, "that little voice inside that tells them when some thing does not feel quite right".

Information required when calling a message centre and (emergency list):

- Children's full names.
- Babysitting location address. (street or gate address)
- A number where employer (parents) can be reached.
- The children's routes to and from school. (In the event child is missing or late from school)
- Trusted neighbors or friends phone numbers.
- Emergency numbers: Poison Information Center,
 Police, Fire Department, and Ambulance.
- Location of the children's health cards.
- Medical Background for each child: allergies, epileptic seizures, etc. (if medication is required, they should know the times and the proper dosage to be given.)
- Having specific instructions for handling incoming calls or actions to be taken if the doorbell rings -NEVER tell anyone who calls or visits that they are alone

Before leaving your babysitting job, to return home:

- Report any unusual happenings when the child's/ children's parents return home
- If a parent is to drive you home but appears to be intoxicated, insist on calling your own parents to make alternate arrangements

Tips for Parents:

Placing the emergency contact information by the

telephone

- Full list of child's names and medical information (numbers) including allergies, medications taken and medical conditions.
- Always leave the following telephone numbers readily available for your babysitter:
 - o Where you can be reached
 - A friend or neighbor who can offer assistance, if necessary
 - o Police, Fire and Ambulance: 9-1-1
 - o The Poison Information Centre in Alberta: 1-800-332-1414
- Remember that when you leave your child/children in the care of a babysitter you are placing a big responsibility on that person
- Selecting A Babysitter:
 - o Look for common sense and maturity
 - Ask friends or neighbors for recommendations/ referrals
 - Let the babysitter you select visit your home prior to the date you will be going out so that both you and your child/children can get to know him/her
 - Note: that some communities offer babysitting courses through the Canada Safety Council.
 Ask your babysitter if they have taken it. If not, suggest they do and perhaps pay for it. You will secure a grateful employee.

Ground Rules:

- Be explicit in your instructions and, if necessary, write out a list of important points regarding your expectations.
- Discourage use of your telephone by your babysitter for lengthy calls to friends.

Once you have chosen your babysitter(s), and have established trust in them, good and lasting relationships will develop. Your child/children will enjoy having them babysit and you will enjoy your time away from home, confident in the knowledge that your family is in good hands. You may also wish to make a checklist of your own and have the babysitter tick off each task as it is completed. The checklist could include tasks as indicated in this article. We hope that by compiling some good babysitting tips, the experience will make for a pleasant experience for everyone. The tips in this article were available from law enforcement and first responders across Canada.
