With great sadness, the family of John Kugyelka, 84, formerly of Breton, AB, now of Sidney, BC, announces his passing on June 17, 2018 at the Palliative Care Unit, Saanich Peninsula Hospital.

Born to George and Juliana Kugyelka (ne Besze) in Tilley, AB, John moved to the Breton area in 1940. He grew up in a time when resources were scarce, and learned early to work hard, be strong and resourceful. He faced a number of health challenges in his life, which he met with courage and dignity, and without compliant. "Not too bad today, I'll feel better tomorrow".

Wed to Elizabeth on June 21, 1958, they remained on their farm near Breton until 2015. A life-long steward of the land, John was a successful farmer, and also worked as a battery operator for Canada City Service, meat cutter at Max and Max Meats in Warburg, school bus driver for 30 years, pedigreed seed grower and seed distributor for Hanna's Seeds. He could do business with a handshake. He had a gentle wit, a kind heart, and could fix most anything. He gladly and generously shared his knowledge and experience, and always stepped up to help a friend or neighbor when needed. He loved a good game of cribbage, and is still working to get that 29 hand.

John joined Breton BPO Elks Lodge #402 in 1956 as a charter member and remained a member until his passing. He took great pride in the fellowship and community service this organization provides. He could see God's miracles in the seeds and the soil and the animals all around him, and was a member of the United Church for 60 years.

John will be sadly and lovingly missed by his wife Elizabeth (neé Vidok), children, Sandra (Dan), Douglas (Stacey) and Janet (Kevin), his grandson David, step-grandchildren, Ian and Farleigh, sister Helen, many nieces, nephews, in-laws and a host of friends. Predeceased by his father and mother, brothers, Louis, George and Steve, and sister Margaret.



# Leduc County co-hosts big rig rescue training

# Eighty firefighters from around the world to train in Nisku

Firefighters from around the world are in Leduc County this weekend learning life-saving skills at the 2018 Big Rig HOT (hands-on training) Symposium.

Leduc County Fire Services and the Alberta Vehicle Extrication Association are hosting the 11th annual training event from June 21 to 23 to provide more than 80 firefighters from more than a dozen departments across Canada, the United States and Chile with life-saving skills.

The participants in this training are exposed to new techniques, tools and technologies specific to big rig rescue situations. These new skills will elevate the level of service that departments can provide and, ultimately, will save lives.

Darrell Fleming, Leduc County Fire Services fire chief and event coordinator/instructor

Over the course of the training, firefighters will actively participate in four workshops with different big rig rescue scenarios, such as responding to under runs – which involve one vehicle passing beneath another – rollovers and complicated stabilization and extrication techniques.

The symposium is held at the regional fire training facility at the Nisku Fire District Station, which includes a two-storey live-fire structure, a liquid petroleum gas structure and a designated area for vehicle and machinery extrication.

About the Alberta Vehicle Extrication Association: The Alberta Vehicle Extrication Association is a proud member of the World Rescue Organization, and is committed to contributing to the reduction of injury and deaths of Albertans involved in transportation emergencies through education, collaboration, partnerships, learning symposiums and challenges.

# Kelly Jensen seeks Federal Conservative Nomination for Yellowhead Riding

(June 15, 2018) Many may know Kelly Jensen for all his years of service with the Royal Canadian Legion Joe Wynne Branch #51, Air Cadet Tiger Moth Squadron in Edson, as Captain Jensen. Kelly Jensen has entered the race for the Conservative MP nomination in the Yellowhead Riding. With Conservative MP Jim Eglinski's announcement on January 9 that he won't be seeking re-election in 2019, the seat will become vacant. MP Eglinski has been in public service for 52 years and feels the time has come to enjoy life's finest moments with family and friends.

Jensen says "I would like to announce that I have recently been approved as a Conservative Party Candidate Nomination Contestant for the Riding of Yellowhead. Since current Member of Parliament Jim Eglinski decided not to run in 2019, the opportunity opened up for other members of the Party to put in their names for the nomination. At present no one knows when the nomination contest will be called, as it will be up to the party to call those dates when they feel it is time."

"The important thing is it will only be members that will be voting in the nomination contest, in the nomination meetings. If a person is not a member of the Federal Conservative Party, they won't be helping to select the candidate." says Jensen.

Kelly Jensen and his family have been in Edson since 1978. Kelly graduated from University of Alberta in 1987, and he has worked for Yellowhead County since 1994 in various capacities, he is currently a Planning and Subdivision officer, and has been a member of the Canadian Forces Reserve for 25 years. There, Jensen was a Cadet Instructor and Commanding Officer of the squadron since 2005. Since 2010 Kelly Jensen has been Aide -de-Camp to the Lieutenant Governor, both with the previous Lieutenant Governor and the current Lieutenant Governor Lois Mitchell. In 2011 Jensen received his National Advanced Certificate in Local Authority Administration Level One and his Level Two in 2014. "I believe in life time learning, it keeps your brain active. These programs have helped to make me a better employee for the County, as it was all knowledge that was related to the Municipal Government. I have a strong understanding of government and bureaucracy. From working at the county for as many years as I have, dealing with the public as a Subdivision Officer, answering questions about by-laws, registration and attending council meetings presenting on the public's behalf, I understand that it takes tact and diplomacy at times when you have to relay unpleasant news back to the parties involved. I

like to understand the by-laws and the legislation. I have been fortunate to have been there when two of the land use by-laws were drafted. It is an advantage, knowing some of the background of where some of these regulations come from, so you can say to people, it's not just a black and white rule. The origin of that thinking came from a steering committee, council or a public meeting where the public has said what they are expecting to be done" stated Jensen.

Kelly and his wife Marsha have two adult kids, their son Elliot is in the Canadian Armed Forces and daughter Emily who is 19 just finished her first year in University. Kelly is also a volunteer for the Yellowhead County Fire Department; he works with the Incident Emergency Response Support Trailer. "Looking after our Fire Fighters is what that big trailer is for. We provide for rehabilitation; look after giving the fire fighters water and something to eat while attending a fire. We refill the air cylinders for the firefighters breathing apparatus, so they can go back out. The unit is called Special Operations, so if there is a fire situation where the firefighters are going to be out for a long time, they will bring out the Incident Support Unit and we are there to look after the firefighters. We need to ensure the firefighters have hydration and food, so they don't exhaust themselves and they can go back out feeling refreshed."

When asked why Jensen has an interest in running for this position his response was "I have worked in public service my whole life, I have worked for the Provincial Government and then for the County for 24 years. Being a member of the military, serving the public and my country has always been a passion of mine. It is a good time for my wife and I to do something different, the kids have grown up and moved away, giving us an opportunity to do more things and to devote time to the Riding. It would be a very interesting career change for us. I have lived in the area for my adult life and I feel I have a strong understanding of what issues our Constituents are facing."

Kelly enjoys marksmanship and teaching the Air Cadets. fishing and family time. One of Jensen's highlights was last year in November when he went to Ottawa to receive a Senate 150 Medal for Community Service which is rare. Jensen said "I wanted to experience the ceremony in the Senate, so I flew myself down to Ottawa for the event. The ceremony itself was very interesting to be a part of. You receive the medal from the Senator that nominated you and the Speaker of the Senate. Later I was invited to have a tour of the Parliament Building, the Centre Block and a tour of the East Block, so being in Ottawa was a very unique and memorable experience for me. My background and experience have given me strong leadership abilities and an understanding of the issues related to rural communities. I will do my best to represent all your issues and concerns at the Federal
