

Public Participation Policy From Christine Burke

Council has recently adopted a new Public Participation Policy.

The purpose of the policy is to define and achieve a consistent and coordinated approach to public engagement at varying levels that will create opportunities for residents, businesses and other stakeholders to contribute to the decision making process by Council regarding future policy, programs, projects and services and identify clearly how public input will be collected and used.

It is the hope that better citizen engagement will contribute to improved transparency and possibly more importantly, provide for our community to be proud of the direction in which our Town is moving with their help.

In addition to the introduction of the policy, a new bylaw is also in process of being bought forward for approval that will provide for alternate methods of public notification for advertising statutory notices through our website and social media site. However, as we recognize that not everyone is engaged in the online community, we will continue to use the traditional outlets such as local news publications or direct mail to reach the fullest and appropriate audience.

Copies of the policy 2018-002 and proposed bylaw 2018-05 are available on line. Copies are also available from the Town Office. Watch for it to be advertised over the coming weeks in the paper.

BYLAW NO. 2018-06 OF THE TOWN OF THORSBY

(hereinafter referred to as "the Municipality")

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

This bylaw authorizes the Council of the Town of Thorsby to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$165,624 for the sewer replacement 52 Street to 53 Street, 53 St Cul-de-sac, 47 Ave and South, Hankin Street and 48 Avenue within the Town of Thorsby Municipal limits

WHEREAS:

The Council of the Town of Thorsby has decided to issue a bylaw pursuant to Section 258 of the *Municipal Government Act* to authorize the financing, undertaking and sewer replacement within the Town of Thorsby.

Requests for proposals have been submitted and specifications have been prepared and the total cost of the project is estimated to be \$165,624 and the Municipality estimates the following grants and contributions will be applied to the project:

 Capital Reserves

 Provincial Grants
 \$000,000

 Debenture(s)
 \$165,624

 Total Cost
 \$165,624

In order to complete the project, it will by necessary for the Municipality to borrow the sum of \$165,624 for a period not to exceed 20 years, from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution, by the issuance of debentures and on the terms and conditions referred to in this bylaw.

The estimated lifetime of the project financed under this bylaw is equal to, or in excess of 25 years.

The principal amount of the outstanding debt of the Municipality at Dec 31, 2017 is \$1,484,034 and no part of the principal or interest is in arrears.

All required approvals for the project have been obtained and the project is in compliance with all Acts and Regulations of the Province of Alberta.

THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF THORSBY DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That for the purpose of purchasing municipal paving the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND SIX HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS be borrowed from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution by way of debenture on the credit and security of the Municipality at large, of which amount the full sum of \$165,624 is to be paid by the Municipality at large.
- 2. The proper Officers of the Municipality are hereby authorized to issue debenture(s) on behalf of the Municipality for the amount and purpose as authorized by this bylaw, namely the sewer replacement.
- 3. The Municipality shall repay the indebtedness according to the repayment <u>structure</u> in <u>effect</u>, <u>namely semi-annual payments of combined principal and interest instalments not to exceed TWENTY (20) years calculated at a rate not exceeding the interest rate fixed by the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution on the date of the borrowing, and not to exceed FIVE (5) percent.</u>
- 4. The Municipality shall levy and raise in each year municipal taxes sufficient to pay the indebtedness.
- 5. The indebtedness shall be contracted on the credit and security of the Municipality.
- 6. The net amount borrowed under the bylaw shall be applied only to the project specified by this bylaw.
- 7. This bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
