At the July 9 Council meeting, on behalf of the Warburg Bloomin' Buddies, we requested that consideration be given to having the road allowance between 52

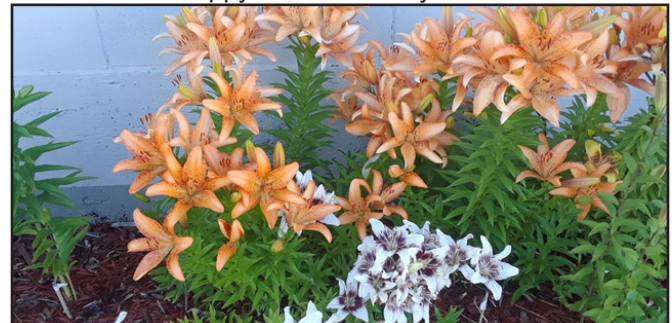

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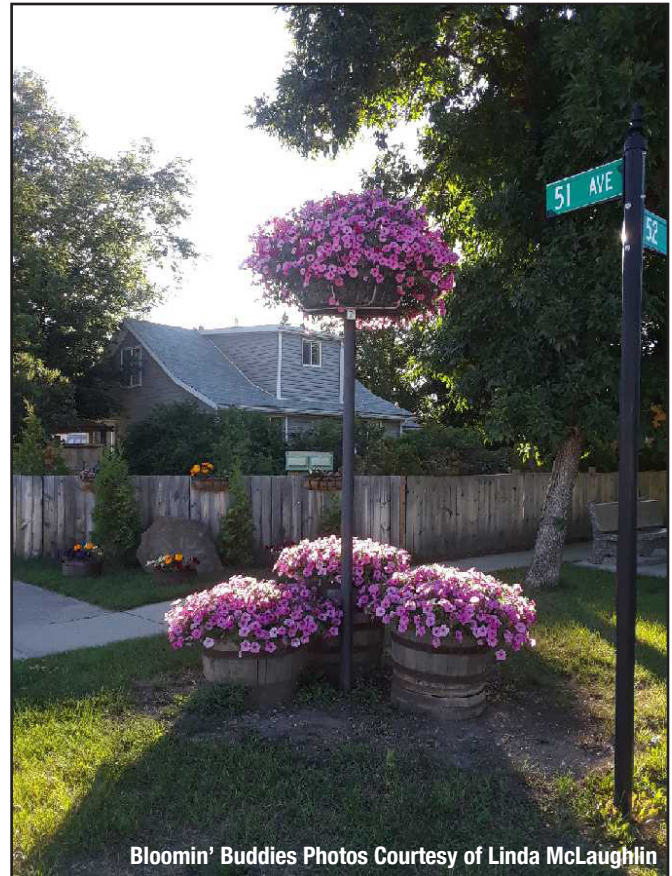

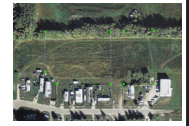
