## Local Archer Brings Home Silver

#### From Dianne Hunter

I have been competing in Archery for two years now. I got into archery because I had the desire to hunt close to the game. I loved stalking up to animals and learning more about them.

I started shooting right away at 3D targets to get better at hunting. In my first shoot I had only owned my bow for 2 weeks!

#### Labour Day Take Along -Parmesan Tomato Chips Get this: they taste just like pizza. YUM!

INGREDIENTS

cooking spray, for cooling rack 15 assorted tomatoes, sliced 1/3" thick 2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil kosher salt Freshly ground black pepper 2 tbsp. Italian seasoning 1/2 c. freshly grated Parmesan

#### DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 275° and grease a cooling rack with cooking spray, then place on top of a large baking sheet.

On a large, paper towel-lined plate, arrange tomatoes and cover with another paper towel, then press out juices. Place tomatoes on cooling rack and lightly drizzle with olive oil, then season generously with salt, pepper and Italian seasoning.

Bake, checking every 30 minutes, until tomatoes are completely dried out and beginning to crisp up, about 3 hours.

Remove from oven and heat broiler. Sprinkle tomatoes with Parmesan, then broil on low until cheese is melty, 1 to 2 minutes. Let cool, then remove from cooling rack. Gar-

nish with additional salt, pepper and Italian seasoning, if desired, and serve.


