School Bus and Zone Reminders

As classes resume for a new school year RCMP are asking motorists to pay attention when encountering school buses and around school zones .

Each year we regrettably see vehicles drive past stopped school buses when they are supposed to stop. This is a very dangerous practice and puts the lives of our children at risk. The fine for "fail to stop before approaching school bus with alternately flashing red lamps " is \$543 and 6 demerit points.

Most drivers are only told about the rules for passing a school bus with flashing red lights when they learn to drive - often many years ago. We would like to remind all drivers of school bus safety practices when school buses are stopped with their yellow or red lights flashing.

- 1. When you see a school bus, assume children will be around and take extra care leave lots of space around the bus.
- 2. When the bus turns on the flashing yellow lights this means it is about to stop to pick up kids. Slow down and prepare to stop.
- 3. When the bus turns on the flashing red lights this means STOP in BOTH directions. Never pass a school bus with flashing red lights in either direction. Stop well back from the bus. If you have any doubt what to do STOP!

School zones are another area where we'd like to remind drivers and students of safety tips and be aware of and watch out for children near schools, sidewalks, crossing streets and in school parking lots.

- 1. Be on the lookout for school zone signals/signs and ALWAYS obey the posted speed limits
- 2. Watch out for school crossing guards and obey their signals
- 3.Be alert and aware, do not drive distracted.





Amy Biehl died a violent death in 1993. She was a 26-year-old Fulbright scholar who had gone to South Africa to help register black voters for their first free election. But even though she was seeking to help the people of South Africa, as she was driving one day, she was dragged out of her car, stabbed and beaten to death by a mob which was committed to violence in order to overthrow the apartheid government. Soon afterward, Amy's parents, Linda and Peter Biehl, quit their jobs and moved from their Orange County, California home to South Africa — not to seek revenge, but to start a foundation in Amy's name. Today, two of her killers work for the foundation. They call Mrs. Biehl "Makhulu," or grandmother, because of the way she treats them. She says, "Forgiving is looking at ourselves and saying, 'I don't want to go through life feeling hateful and seeking revenge, because that's not going to do me any good.' We took Amy's lead. We did what we felt she would want."

That is the picture of reconciliation. It not only forgives, it reaches out to restore. It pays back good for evil. It is following the heart and character of God, for the Bible says, "All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation" (2 Corinthians 5:18-19). I am so grateful that God made the sacrifice to reconcile someone like me to Himself. even in spite of all that I have done. Now I want to follow the example of Jesus and offer that same reconciliation to others — even those who may have harmed me. What a difference we can make in our homes, in our communities, and in the world around us if we take the attitude of Linda and Peter Biehl and of course the attitude of Christ and offer forgiveness and reconciliation instead of anger and revenge.
