Connect Parent Group Comes to Breton

From Alberta Health Services

CONNECT is not a step by step how to parent course!

CONNECT is a parenting class that teaches the concept of attachment and how it is critical in all relationships. (children/teen/young adults/personal).

Parents/caregivers who attend Connect will learn principles that will help them and their children create healthy relationships, have healthy conflict and navigate through the natural relationship changes.

It is research supported and evidence based. The principles taught are transferable to all relationships in life. The principles are sound for young children, teens and our personal relationships. Healthy connected families assist children to be successful.

We understand that each child and each parent is different and change is part of development. Rather than teach only one way of parenting, we help parents see choices that support healthy relationships while setting limits.

Parents meet in small groups with two trained group leaders for one hour each week for 10 weeks. Each session provides parents with a new perspective on parent-child/teen relationships and development. Parents watch role-plays, try exercises and work together to develop new choices for responding to their child's difficult behaviour while building and strengthening their attachment to their child. Parents receive handouts following each session with key points to remember.

Bestselling author coming to Breton on October 10th

Bestselling historical novelist Elinor Florence will present a fascinating glimpse into the past at the Breton Municipal Library on Wednesday, October 10.

The granddaughter of homesteaders, Elinor now lives in Invermere, B.C. but she grew up on a farm outside North Battleford, Saskatchewan. Her love of pioneer history is evident in both her new novel *Wildwood* and her wartime novel *Bird's Eye View*. Using vintage photographs, the author will present a one-hour slide show illustrating the research behind her novels and tell some unusual anecdotes.

Wildwood features a single mother from the big city of Phoenix, Arizona, who inherits an abandoned farm in the remote backwoods of northern Alberta, on condition that she lives there off the grid for one year. Molly and her little daughter Bridget move to the farm called *Wildwood*, where Molly teaches herself the basic pioneer skills - cooking on a wood stove using only the *Five Roses Cook Book*, chopping firewood, and melting snow to do her laundry - but her greatest perils are presented by the wilderness itself. In the old farmhouse, Molly finds the journal written in 1924 by her courageous great-aunt, the land's original homesteader, and reading about the early days inspires Molly to persevere against all the odds.

According to a recent review in *U.S. Publishers Weekly*: "Molly's experience of her great-aunt's way of life is so vividly described that readers will appreciate the strength and courage of past generations."

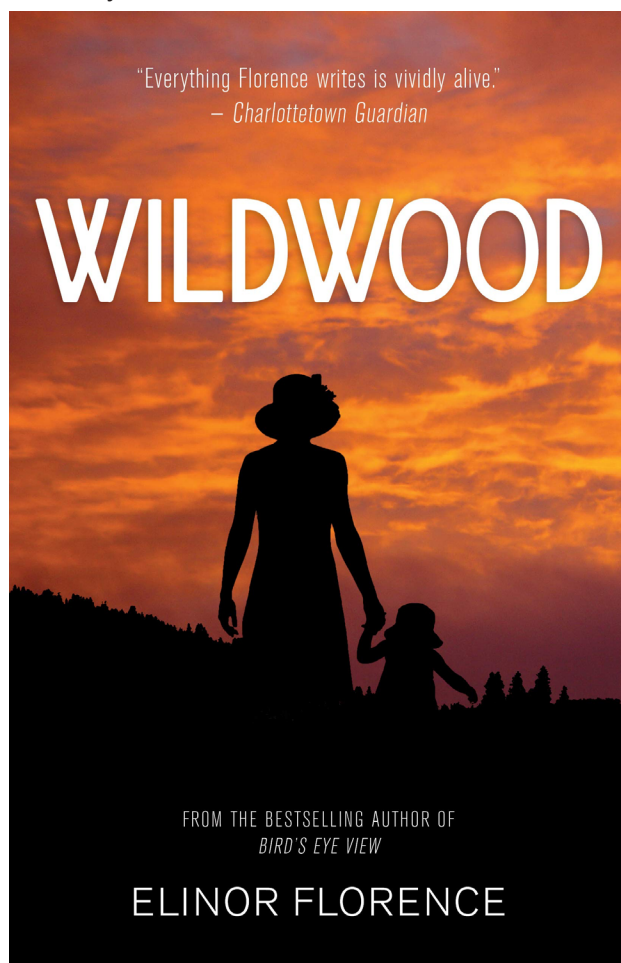
The author will also sign copies of her first novel *Bird's Eye View*, which became a *Toronto Star* bestseller. It tells the story of a farm girl from Saskatchewan who joins the Royal Canadian Air Force

and serves overseas as an aerial photographic interpreter.

A journalist who began her career with *The Western Producer* in Saskatoon, Elinor continues to write a monthly column for *The Senior Paper* based in Regina. Her novels are popular with both men and women, book club members, seniors, and anyone interested in our proud prairie history.
