

COMMUNITY STANDARDS BYLAW AMENDMENT

Community Standards Bylaw #2016-18 section 2.7.4 prohibits the deposit of commercial flyers/ private flyers, advertisements on power poles, light standards, municipal trees, benches, flower containers, garbage cans, sign posts, or other municipal, provincial or federal properties.

While the intent of the bylaw is to limit visual nuisance and unsightly/unmaintained advertisements throughout the community, it also restricts the ability to allow community appropriate material to be displayed.

The proposed change will allow for the issue of a no fee permit to allow community appropriate material to be displayed and which will control the responsibility issues of maintenance, take down dates etc.

ADVERTISING BYLAW 2018-05

As part of recent changes to the Municipal Government Act s.216.1 (1) requiring that municipalities adopt a public participation policy, the modifications also recognize that electronic communication is widespread in todays society and allows for notification of statutory notices by electronic means.

Bylaw 2018-08 provides for the additional methods of communication/notice to Thorsby residents via electronic means. However, it is not the intent of Council to change only to electronic/digital notification methods as we recognize that not all our residents have access to electronic devices. It will merely provide for an additional method of communication as we continue to work to better engage the community .



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Since the late 60s the field of collectable advertising has grown tremendously. Beautiful examples of early advertising appeal to the nostalgia in all of us representing a small part of the good old days. Manufacturers went to great lengths to decorate their signs, posters, statues, emblems and cans advertising the quality goods they offered.

The earlier examples of old advertising were paper, usually chromolithographs. Full colour signs and packaging often required a dozen or more plates, each using a specific colour. That quality achieved is seldom matched by the 4 colour process in common usage today.

Next came tin. The technology required to reproduce colour lithography on Tin became available in the 1880,s. It is highly desirable today and includes a whole spectrum of collectables even tin litho toys.

Reverse painting on glass required a great deal of handwork and was the most expensive to produce. The brilliance and depth of colour was unmatched. Many of these signs contained such special features as gold or silver leaf, decals, crackled glass, stained glass and even mother of pearl. This form of advertising is rare with many collectors considering reverse glass to be the finest type of early advertising The Porcelain sign was developed in the 1880s. Many early Porcelains advertising North American companies were produced in England. Porcelain signs do not have the detail of lithographed paper or tin, nor the colour of reverse glass but they can withstand outdoor climates and that has made them the king of advertising Collectibles.

Rounding out Collectible advertising is celluloid and leaded stained glass. Celluloid was used in mirrors, keychains, small box adver-

tising while stained glass more for permanent fixed advertising.

Conditioning is very important in considering value ranging from Mint or New Condition to below fair.


After serving as Fire Chief at the City of St. Albert, Lefebvre is happy to be back in Nisku, where his passion for firefighting began.

I play rugby, so as a sports analogy, this is like coming back as head coach of the team that gave you your first break – which is a team that will always be close to your heart.


