Phase one of Warburg Arena upgrades underway

From Leduc County & Village of Warburg

Construction has officially started on phase one of the Warburg Arena upgrades, thanks to a strong partnership between Leduc County, the Village of Warburg and the Warburg Arena Board.

The \$2.4 million upgrade, funded through a partnership agreement between Leduc County, the Village of Warburg and provincial grant funding, will bring a larger, improved dressing room area to the arena and will improve access to the ice surface.

The Warburg Arena Board has many dedicated volunteers who help to provide a safe and high quality establishment for the community. These upgrades will carry on the efforts of the volunteers and will increase community capacity for various recreational events held at the arena.

ALBERT & MARIA RIMER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

In memory of his parents (Mr. and Mrs. Albert Rimer), Mr. Bert Rimer has provided Leduc County the sum of \$50,000 for a scholarship for a student who attains his or her high school diploma from Warburg High School and continues further education, through an accredited college or university, in the field of Agriculture and/or Agricultural/Food. Secondary consideration will be provided to those students entering the field of Health Sciences (medical field). The scholarship is to be known as the Albert & Maria Rimer Memorial Scholarship.

AWARD

Amount to be determined by the interest accumulated on the investment during the preceding year. However, the scholarship provided will not be less than \$1,000 in any given year.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, the student must:

- have graduated from Warburg High School
- have declared a major in the field of Agriculture and/or Agricultural/Food
- secondary consideration will be provided students who have declared a major in the field of Health Sciences (medical field)
- financial need will be considered in the awarding of the scholarship
- must not have previously received this scholarship





Children & Technology

As kids spend more and more time using devices, issues like text neck become real developmental threats. Use of these devices often reinforces poor posture. Associated risks include: headaches; neck and shoulder pain; upper and lower back pain; and sore hands, fingers and forearms.

Tips

- Limit or minimize the hours your child sits with their device(s).
- Kids are meant to move! Ensure your child is getting regular physical activity.
- When sitting, encourage your child to sit up straight with chest out and shoulders back.
- If your child must look down at their device, encourage them to tuck their chin into their neck instead of hanging their head forward.
- Make sure your kids stretch their hand, shoulder and neck muscles to strengthen their posture.
