

Notice to producers: silaging, mud and the travelling public

The recent wet weather has created unfavourable road conditions and extremely soggy farmer's fields. Currently, many producers are trying to take silage off of their fields. These wet conditions are not only making it difficult for farmers to silage, but are also creating hazardous road conditions due to mud being dragged from fields onto roads.

The mud poses a public safety hazard, and the safety of our travelling public is Leduc County's number one concern. We understand the pressure our producers are under, and we want to work with them to ensure the safety of the travelling public is considered while harvesting agricultural crops. 



Changes to Parental Benefits

OTTAWA: Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to inform residents that the Government of Canada has announced that Employment and Social Development Canada intends to launch the new parental sharing benefit on March 17, 2019.

This new measure will provide an additional five weeks of Employment Insurance (EI) parental benefits when parents agree to share parental benefits, or an additional eight weeks for those who choose the extended parental benefit option. Parents with children born or placed for adoption on or after March 17, 2019, will be eligible.

As women make 85 percent of all parental claims and take longer leaves from the workplace, the EI parental sharing measure allows pregnant workers and their families to consider their personal, health and workplace circumstances when choosing when to begin their maternity leave.

Benefit Changes for Families with Critically ill Loved Ones

OTTAWA: Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to inform residents that the Government of Canada has moved forward with the following changes to the Employment Insurance (EI) program in order to better support workers who take time off work due to specific life events:

Caregivers who provide care to a critically ill or injured adult family member now have access to a new benefit of up to 15 weeks.

Immediate and extended family members of children who are critically ill will now have access to a new benefit that was previously available only to parents. It replaces the Parents of Critically III Children Benefit and continues to provide up to 35 weeks of benefits.

Parents are able to choose the option that best meets their family's needs: standard parental benefits (taken over 12 months at a benefit rate of 55 percent) or extended parental benefits (taken over 18 months at a benefit rate of 33 percent).

Eligible pregnant workers are able to receive El maternity benefits earlier, up to 12 weeks before their due date. This increased flexibility allows pregnant workers to consider their personal, health and workplace circumstances when choosing when to begin their maternity leave.

These changes apply to EI-eligible workers, as well as self-employed Canadians who opt into the EI program for access to EI special benefits, and who meet minimum income and other requirements to qualify for EI special benefits. These improvements were informed by consultations on EI maternity, parental and caregiving benefits.


