The Poster Contest - Having two divisions of Colour or Black & White, this is broken up into 4 categories : Kindergarten, Junior , Intermediate and Senior. These students will submit drawings, sketches focusing on Remembrance, illustrating Canadian symbols, provincial flags, coats of arms, loss of our veterans, representation of flowers, the Poppy and Forget-Me-Not, birds, animals, Canadian historical and current military dress, etc.

The Literary Contest – This contest also has two divisions, Essays and Poems relating to events, personal expression in the art of writing or poetry.

Judging all the tremendous entries submitted is done at the local level in the Legion Branch based on guidelines from the Royal Canadian Legion. Prizes are awarded, and First Place entries are submitted at Provincial Level by The Royal Canadian Legion command, then onto Ottawa, where they are reviewed at National Level. These winning works of art are displayed in a magazine, in Parliament, and the winners are flown to Ottawa to meet the Lieutenant Governor General.

Meet Kieran - Advocate for Rural Albertans

Kieran Quirke was elected to the Alberta NDP Rural Caucus Co-Chair role April 28, where he advocates on behalf of rural Albertans, communities, and businesses to the Alberta NDP. June 23, he was nominated the Alberta NDP Candidate for Drayton Valley-Devon. "I believe that Rachel Notley and the NDP are working hard for an economy that works for everyone. She's fighting for Albertans and she has a hopeful and inclusive vision for Alberta's future. I want to be a part of that. Alberta cannot stay stuck on the boom-bust roller coaster, and Albertans were clear about that in 2015."

Born in Cold Lake and raised in Edmonton, Kieran is the oldest child of Moira and Michael Quirke, both from farm families in Ontario and Ireland, who then became entrepreneurs in Alberta's oil and gas sector. Kieran believes growing up in a household of farmers and businesspeople taught him the importance of hard work, community strength, personal integrity, and relationships – all traits he brings with his efforts to help the communities in Drayton Valley-Devon today.

Kieran holds a Bachelor of Management in Marketing from the University of Lethbridge, with two Management diplomas from Grant MacEwan University: International Business with a focus on Asia, and Small Business Management.

Before entering politics, he was an Oil and Gas Fabrication CEO, an Industrial Construction General Manager, and a Pulse Crop Grader. He currently sits as Chair of the Leduc-Nisku Economic Development Association Board, and Board Member of the Leduc #1 Energy Discovery Centre. "When oil collapsed in 2015, there were no real supports for affected businesses or families. After decades of PC government and still not having a good plan in place for the cyclical nature of Alberta's oil and gas sector, this was unacceptable and it was clear something had to change. I understand what an economy that works for everyone looks like, and I've seen the work that Rachel Notley and this government have done to accomplish this. When I read about the plans to diversify the economy and build a recovery that lasts for the people of Alberta, while also improving Health, Education, and Environment, I came to believe this was what we needed in Alberta so we can get out of the boom-bust cycle and grow strong for our future. That's why I chose to run on Rachel's team in Drayton Valley-Devon."

Since 2005, Kieran has served communities in various

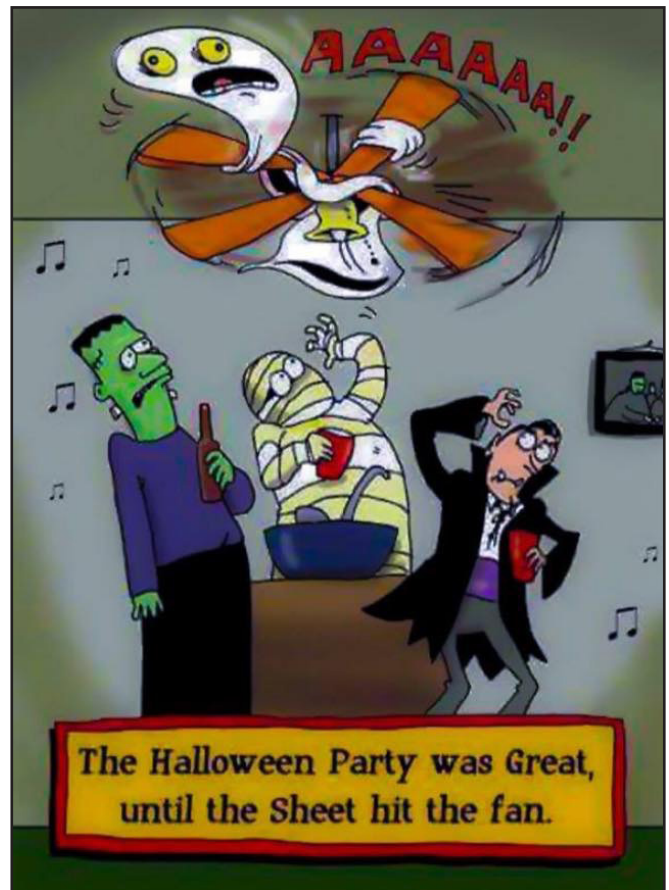

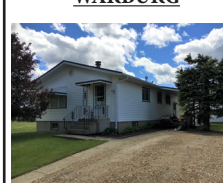
