Special Moments in this Event:

Recognition of Armistice 1918 – 2018 The End of the War

Presentation and Re-dedication of the Victoria Cross to Marg McKinnon from Breton whose Great Uncle had been a Victoria Cross Recipient in World War I. Presentation was made to Marg McKinnon by Master Seaman Dan Morris CD from the Edmonton Garrison.

Three Silver Cross Mothers, Susie Szepsi, Joan Sommer & Linda Block laid the wreath on behalf of all Sliver Cross Mothers and they represented the memory of their Great Grandfather, Great Uncle and their father who had been in the war.

Mr. Don Mosicki presented us with a poem from a young family member who had been an Honorable Mention for her Poem in Ontario through the Poster and Literacy Contest.

MLA Mark Smith spoke to all of us about a soldier George Price who was shot at 10:58AM, two minutes from the hour of peace 11:00AM. This was a very notable topic about this young man who was in the service and how he is honored today.

Bells of Peace – The Royal Canadian Legion presented to all branches an opportunity to ring in the end of the war. When the war ended, bells from the churches or town halls could be heard across the country side to celebrate peace. In Warburg, Comrade Allan Gruninger and Comrade Frank Moar rang the bells in the cemetery to honor this tradition at 11:00PM on Remembrance Day.
