
Reggie D. Pomeranz passed away suddenly in a motorcycle accident in Maricopa, Arizona, on Friday, April 12th, at the age of 54.

NOTICE OF JOINT PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT THE LEDUC COUNTY / TOWN OF THORSBY INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Leduc County council and Town of Thorsby council propose to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP). The IDP sets out guidelines for orderly collaborative growth and development between the two municipalities within the IDP boundary for the next 20 years.

A joint public hearing to consider the IDP will be held **on Thursday, May 2, 2019 at 7:30 p.m.** in the Thorsby and District Community Centre (4813 49 Street, Thorsby), at which time written and oral submissions may be presented to council. Submissions may be made by any person(s) who claim to be affected by the proposed bylaw or from any other person whom the councils agree to hear.

Any written submissions that are mailed, emailed, faxed or delivered to Leduc County or the Town of Thorsby **by 12 p.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2019**, will be included on the council agenda. Individuals wishing to make oral submissions at the public hearing are requested to register by the deadline indicated above.

If you make a written submission, the information you provide may be made public, subject to the provisions of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. Copies of the proposed bylaw and any supporting information may be inspected at the Leduc County Planning and Development office or at the Town of Thorsby office, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, or online at *leduc-county.com* or *thorsby.ca*.

RICHARD (RICK) POPIK

BACK TO SANTOS

Rick applied to and was hired by Santos once more. The next fifteen years were spent with the company at various locations. Still stationed at Lucinda he became Senior Petroleum Engineer for Queensland Operations. Fracing and workover (service) rig activities were some of his responsibilities. Between 2003 AND 2004 he was Project Monitor for the JALBU Oil Field Upgrade, then promoted to Oil Supervisor for Cooper Basin Oil Operations where he was tasked with the optimization of production and run-life of all wells. He maintained this position until 2008. In 2007 he had moved to Townsville in northern Queensland and lived there until 2014 when the move to Wurtulla, southern Queensland, on the Sunshine Coast was made. From 2008 to 2015 he was Completions Field Supervisor in various Queensland coal seam gas fields. Then the bottom fell out of the world price of oil. In 2015, he, along with thousands of others across the world became redundant by the global downturn in oil prices. He realizes he was lucky, compared to others, because for the first time in 41 vears retirement or at least semi-retirement beckoned.

During the last four years Rick has carried out consulting jobs including supervising drilling, well testing and wireline activities. As of April 2019 Origin Energy has him inspecting well sites in the Melbourne area.

FAMILY

As previously mentioned, Rick married Vicki in

1989. They have two children: Teyanah, an awardwinning hair stylist who spent several months in Canada this past year, and Jayden her older brother. Rick and Jayden share April birthdays and they will celebrate together when Jayden turns 25 and Rick 65. Both have serious thirsts to quench. Jayden is an aspiring actor and is close to the theatre scene in his adopted home city of Melbourne. PHILOSOPHY OF LIFE

Rick puts it this way: - I said I'd never work in Fort McMurray – I spent three years ther! I said I'd never work in Wabasca – I spent seven years there! When Santos Ltd. took over from Delhi Petroleum I said I would never work for them – I worked for them for twenty-six years! SO NEVER SAY NEV-ER!
