It's Time For A Spin On Senior's Needs

The bus will depart from the Thorsby Rec Complex parking lot at 12:30 p.m. on Monday, April 29th. This excursion will take about 3 hours and is based on seating availability, once the bus is full, no further reservations can be taken.




