





May long weekend traffic operations focus on safety

Leduc County peace officers issue 21 charges, 16 warnings

Leduc County peace officers welcomed the spring season with a number of proactive enforcement operations over the Victoria Day long weekend. Over the four-day period from May 17 to May 20, peace officers travelled 2,941 kilometres and issued a total of 21 charges and 16 warnings for speeding, intersection safety, and gaming and li-

quor violations.

This past weekend our peace officers charged 19 drivers with speeding. Although we are disappointed that motorists continue to drive above posted speed limits, we are pleased with the significant decline in the number of charges laid compared to last year. We will continue to patrol roadways in the area to make sure motorists can get where they are going safely. Clarence Nelson, director of Enforcement Services

Three excessive speeders were charged, including a vehicle travelling 128 kilometres per hour in a 90-kilometre-per-hour zone on Airport Road near Nisku. Two additional motorists were charged with speeding at more than 30 kilometres per hour over the posted speed limit.

In addition to traffic operations, peace officers assisted Leduc County Fire Services at the scene of three separate incidents.

In 2018, peace officers issued 55 charges and 31 warnings over the same four-day period.

GROWING UP IN THORSBY AND FAMILY TIES.

Growing up in Thorsby was a very positive experience. I had great role models in my life beginning with two wonderful parents, Dave and Alma Ruff, and three sisters who looked out for me over and over. To this day we are a very close family even though Dad and Mom are no longer with us. We carry on our family traditions - I do not know how many families can say that they celebrate every Christmas together as we do. We are lucky in that our parents raised us to appreciate the value of your family. Even with our parents gone now, bless their souls, we continue the well-established traditions. We celebrate the holiday together and we each take a turn at hosting the festive occasion. I am very proud to say that, at one point in time, we actually had four generations of family members together to celebrate. I am not the only one of the family who has achieved success. The four of us were brought up to be respectful and caring and all developed a very strong work ethic. We were raised to be independent females and we have accomplished what we believe to be successful and rewarding careers.* (see below)

As a youngster I had various jobs, ranging from working in the theatre, baby sitting, short order cooking at the snack bar (located where the Town Office is today), cleaning houses and gardening for the elderly. I joined and was active in the Brownies, Girl Guides, Explorers and C.G.I.T. Later on I played on a ladies softball team. At school I participated in the young Voyageurs program. We hosted students from New Brunswick and

we were hosted by families in Quebec. I played many school sports and won some awards. In 1972-73 Thorsby won the provincial girls' basketball championship in Redwater. I played on the team during the regular season but as I was only in grade nine, did not participate in the finals. In high school I got some excellent experience by organizing a curling program and setting up various bonspiels. That year I won an award as school Athlete of the Year.

EDUCATION

I graduated from THS in 1976 and enrolled at the University of Alberta. In 1980 I graduated with a B.ED (major in P.Ed, minor in Sociology) and embarked on a career that was to last 33 years, all in the County of Lac Ste. Anne.

THE WORKING LIFE

My first job was teaching physical education at Mayerthorpe High. I coached everything from soccer to volleyball, basketball to badminton and track and field between 1980 and 1990. The Team Handball program saw us advance to the Winter Games numerous times. I was awarded Coach of the Year in the County, sponsored by Blue Ridge Lumber and had a Sr. Girls' Volleyball team that won the zones and moved on to the Provincials in Chestermere(late '80's)

In 1990 I took a position as assistant principal at Sangudo Jr. Sr. High school and remained there one year at which time I moved back to Mayerthorpe as assistant principal of the High School. I was in that position for 18 years. In 2009 I became principal of the school and finally retired in 2013 after 33 years in education.

As an administrator I am most proud of my success in organizing the Interagency Committee. It was composed of such agencies as school administration, school counselling, R.C.M.P., social services and probation officer. The goal was to help children at risk and provide them with necessary supports In 1990 I took a position as assistant principal at Sangudo Jr. Sr. High school and remained there one year at which time I moved back to Mayerthorpe as assistant principal of the High School. I was in that position for 18 years. In 2009 I became principal of the school and finally retired in 2013 after 33 years in education.

The goal was to help children at risk and provide them with necessary supports to keep them working in a posi-

tive way to turn their life around.

I was able to start the Mayerthorpe Chapter of S.A.D.D. (Students Against Drinking and Driving). We attended many conferences at the provincial level. I applied for a grant and we received \$25,000 that made it possible to attend the National Conference in New Brunswick. Our students were able to make a difference with their campaigns and letters of recognition from the local R.C.M.P., and K Division out of Edmonton attested to this. I became an advocate for Victim Services.

On a personal level I played fastball, curled, golfed and taught aerobic exercise classes in the community.

PHILOSOPHY OF LIFE

- 1. Over the years as an educator I learned a great deal about students, their families and unfortunately about the extra baggage the students often walk into school with. Sometimes they show up physically but mentally they are not present. To them the school is a safe haven. In such a situation we need to show empathy, encourage learning and let them know we care.
- 2. All human beings (including students) have positive qualities that we need to tap into. Kids make bad choices as we all do at some point in our lives. As an administrator I found that when students got into trouble (fighting, using inappropriate language, breaking rules), that, although there were consequences for their actions they were still good people who had made bad choices. The discussion would be based on how the situation could have been handled differently so that the same thing would not happen again.

LIFE AS of NOW

My husband Doug and I continue to farm at Sangudo. We both enjoy the outdoors – quadding, camping and our dog Misty. I sub at Mayerthorpe and am an active member on the Youth Justice Committee for our jurisdiction. I have a huge garden and flowers to brighten up our yard.

FINALLY I WOULD LEAVE THIS COMMENT:

I remember in Grade 8 we read a story called The Lottery . To this day I do believe that life is like a lottery – when your number is drawn, your time is up. So we all need to make the most of life, try not to worry about things we have no control over and, most of all, MOVE FOREWARD.
