

that pertains to school and school division policies and student life at Warburg School. This handbook will be reviewed at our first school council meeting this year so come out to the meeting if you want to discuss it.


The provincial government has discontinued funding the school nutrition program. However, we hope to receive donations from individuals and corporations to support our breakfast program for three days a week. We really need volunteers to help out with this. We have a new sign-in station for visitors to our school. This is located right outside the main office. It is a computer station that you can easily sign-in and out when you come into the school for any reason. All parents are considered visitors to our school and we ask that you sign in and out every time you are in the school building.

Please note that the road in front of the school is considered a school zone right before and after school. This means that general traffic (parents, students) should not be coming down that road during bus drop off and pick up. For the sake of student safety please do not use this road while buses are in use. On that note, please take caution when using our "Kiss-n-Go" drop of at the east/museum doors. There are a lot of little ones that use that door and it is your responsibility as a driver to be aware of your surroundings.

Teachers, secretaries, our librarian, EAs and custodians have all really worked hard in preparations for our new school year. The exterior of the school has been painted and the floors are shiny. We are ready and very excited for you to join us




