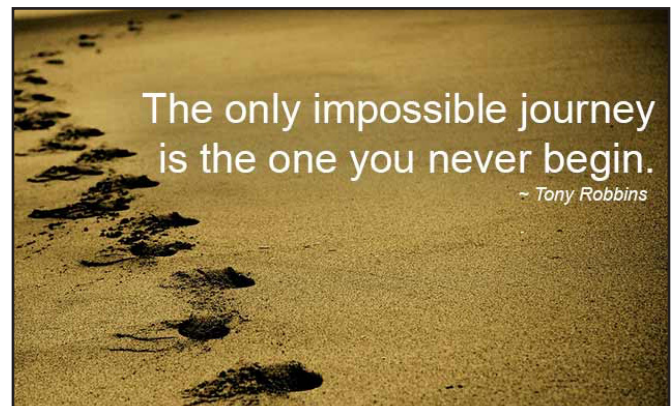

Every year, research is done to look into which strains of flu will be most common and the province creates an immunization program. This year's flu program has already begun at Royal Care. Our Pharmacists can give the flu shot free of charge to anyone 9 years and older. Otherwise, public health clinics and your family doctor are among many other places you can get the flu shot. Other ways to protect yourself from the flu include diligent hand washing and staying at home if you yourself are infected.

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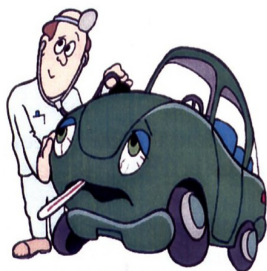

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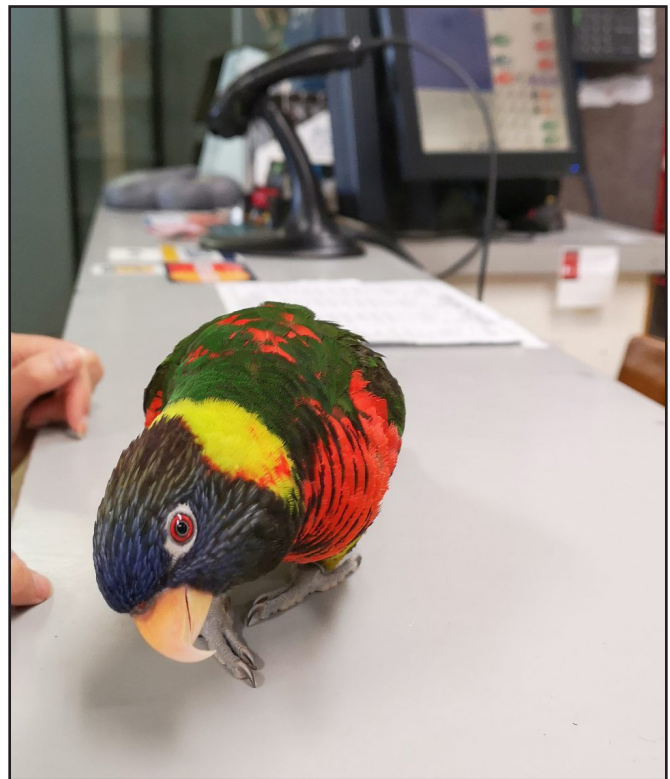

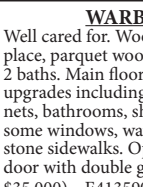
