

- have a total household income of less than \$60,000 a year (as a couple) or less than \$40,000 (as a single).

Housekeeping fees are determined based on family income level and eligibility to other subsidies. The services are provided through a partnership with *Serving Hands Senior Care Inc.*Seniors Services also offers one-to-one support to assist you with:

- Information and referrals to other local resources
- Assistance with forms and applications
- Advocacy and coordination of services
- Goal setting and future planning direction





I am proud to say that I was born and raised in Thorsby by my parents John and Lil Hier and grew up with four siblings - Doreen (Hostyn), Veona (Zingel), Lyle and Donald. I have seen Thorsby grow from a Hamlet, to a Village (of which my father was the first mayor) to the Town it is now today.

Needless to say, life has changed a lot from those days. Unless you lived out of town and had to be bussed to school, most kids walked to and from school. When we were in high school you needed permission from the Principal to bring a vehicle to school and you needed a pretty valid reason to do that. We went to school ALL day EVERY day. I remember older people telling me that high school would be some of the best times of my life and me thinking that they were crazy. Looking back now I realize that they were right. I still occasionally see some of my old classmates whenever I get the chance to visit Thorsby and enjoy those chance meetings immensely. In 1979 I started working at Thorsby Elementary School as the Library Clerk which I did for two years and then took over the Secretary position which I held until my retirement in 2010. Both of our daughters also graduated from Thorsby High School. Tammy went on to the University of Calgary where she obtained her Bachelor of Education Degree and Melanie attended N.A.I.T. and graduated as an Interior Design Technologist. Sadly we lost Melanie to lukemia in November of 2000. Tammy taught school in Calgary, married Ryan Hewitt, who also graduated from Thorsby High, and they have made us the delighted grandparents of two wonderful grandchildren, Tristan and Emma. They are all presently living in Calgary and making both of us very proud of all of them for their accomplishments.

In 1997, with Larry now working in Drayton Valley for his brother-in-law Les Huber, we decided to move again. This time we moved to a condominium community right on a golf course just east of Drayton Valley, where we presently reside. Larry also partially retired in 2010 and fully retired in 2014. We are both still in reasonably good health, enjoy our life here, have made many wonderful new friends and have no plans to leave here in the foreseeable future.




