



An interesting map is on display in the British Museum in London. It's an old mariner's chart, drawn in 1525, outlining the North American coastline and adjacent waters. The cartographer made some intriguing notations on areas of the map that represented regions not yet explored. He wrote: "Here be giants," "Here be fiery scorpions," and "Here be dragons." Eventually, the map came into the possession of Sir John Franklin, a British explorer in the early 1800s. Scratching out the fearful inscriptions, he wrote these words across the map: "Here is God."

There is much in life that can cause us to live in fear or anxiety. I read a quote from missionary Elizabeth Elliot whose husband was killed by the Huaorani tribe while on missions in Ecuador. She said; "fear arises when we think everything depends on us." How true that statement is. Fear then is calmed when we realize that we are not alone, and that God goes before us. Next time you are anxious or fearful remember God's words to Joshua, and speak them over your own life. "Have I not commanded you, be strong and courageous? Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go!"






