





Waste Transfer Site

The Waste Transfer Site is now on winter hours. The site will be open Saturdays only from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Property Taxes

All outstanding taxes are due by December 31st. A penalty of 15% will be levied January 1st, 2020 on taxes and related costs that remail unpaid.

Utility Payments

Due December 31st.

All December 31st payments for taxes and utilities will be honored without penalties until close of business on January 2nd.

Tax Installment Payment Plan

The Village of Breton Tax Installment Payment Plan Bylaw allows taxes to be paid in twelve monthly installments over the course of the taxation year (January to December). Eligibility for the Plan is contingent upon the prior year's taxes being paid in full, and application must be made by **December 15th** in the year prior to the year in which the plan is to commence. The first six payments of the year will be calculated as 1/12 (one twelfth) of the prior year's tax levy. The last six payments will be 1/6 (one sixth) of the actual amount outstanding of July 1st (Current year's tax levy less the amounts paid from January to June). A tax payer may enroll up to June 30th, but a "catch-up" payment would be required to cover those payments that would have been made between January and the date of enrollment. Should you have any questions regarding the Tax Installment Payment Plan, please contact the Village Office at 780-696-3636.

Sidewalks

Residents and business owners are reminded they must by Bylaw 07-01 Section 7.17 keep their sidewalks free from snow and ice within 48 hours of a snowfall. Please use ice melt instead of salt to avoid damaging the sidewalk. You are responsible for the cleaning of the sidewalk even if the property is vacant.



Do what is most important – Holidays are generally packed with activity. There is often the pressure and


stress of having so much to do and so little time to do it in. You need to set priorities; don't over-extend or attempt to do it all.




