





Straight Out of Thorsby

BOB GREEN AND LINDA GREEN (NEE CAMPBELL)

We are writing this article together since we were born and grew up in the Thorsby area. We both attended Thorsby schools from Grades 1 through 12, started dating in Grade 11, started our work careers in Calgary and of course, got married.

REMEMBRANCES OF THORSBY

Bob grew up on a farm south of Thorsby and just north of Pigeon Lake. In fact, if I had lived on the south side of the road, I would have gone to Pigeon Lake Regional and my story would probably be a lot different. Riding the bus was just a fact of life and being near the start of the route, an hour's ride was normal. John Hier was the bus driver through elementary grades and Arnold Kisser was John's replacement when he retired. The stores stayed open late on Saturday night's, so that's when we made our way into town for groceries.

Linda lived in Thorsby since her father Hugh had an oilfield job and her mother Margaret was a teacher. Being in a small town meant you could walk everywhere. Walking home from school we could stop at the cheese factory to see if they had any fresh cheese curds!

SCHOOL DAYS

In our graduating year, 1972, there were a grand total of 90 students at THS. This meant that, to have sports teams, especially football, you had to rely on a large portion of stu-dents to participate. Our curriculum was basic, general or matriculation, depending on the post-secondary schooling you wanted to attend after graduation. Optional classes were almost never heard of.

Bob participated on most of the teams throughout high school. Grade 12 sports included football, basketball, volleyball and track & field. Coach Elson would organize exhibition games and tournaments with larger schools (Wetaskiwin and Leduc) for the basketball team to get used to tough competition. Our teams were very successful at both basket-ball and volleyball, going to the Provincials in both sports. A lot of our success was due to great coaches, John Elson, Sam Kobeluck and Brian Cunningham. Basics, discipline and respect were core values that the teams were expected to adhere to. No time left for hockey or curling.

Linda participated in a few after school clubs and was assistant editor of the school paper. Not an athlete except to learn how to curl she became a cheerleader instead.

FURTHER EDUCATION

After graduation, Bob, along with Richard Popik, enrolled in the Gas Technology program at NAIT. Sports again became a part of schooling. Bob played for the NAIT Oopiks bas-ketball team for the 1972-1973 and 1973-1974 seasons. Coach of the NAIT team was Jules Owchar who went on to coach the Kevin Martin team of curling fame.
