NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

TAKE NOTICE that the Councils of Brazeau County and the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 will be holding public hearings with regard to the Brazeau County and County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP). An IDP is a document required by the *Municipal Government Act*, which ensures future development and land use policy is coordinated between municipalities, reduces the possibility of any potential conflicts between Counties and ensures the relationship remains collaborative. The proposed Brazeau County and County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 IDP Plan Area has been revised since the September 9, 2019 public open house from 1.6 kilometre buffer on either side of the municipal boundary to 800 metres. The updated plan area is shown on the map below.



TAKE NOTICE that <u>Brazeau County Council</u> will hold a Public Hearing for the proposed adoption of the IDP at which any person claiming to be affected by the proposed IDP may ask questions or make their views known. **The Public Hearing will be held on January 21, 2021 at 10:15 am** or as soon thereafter as possible in the Council Chambers of Brazeau County office at 7401 Township Road 494, Drayton Valley, Alberta.
