Grade 2 Students Save the World From Laurie Gellert

Mrs. Walker's grade 2 class intend to do just that by saving Thorsby first! They want to spread the word about the dangers of littering and plastics in their town to help lessen the environmental impact globally.

These environmentally concious 7 and 8 year olds started discussing what they could do to help the environment after classmate, Rowan Anderson told them about "The Great Pacific Garbage Patch", in a sharing circle one morning in December. This "Garbage Patch", they informed me, was the biggest of 5 islands of garbage in our oceans. In area, twice as big as the state of Texas and over 10 metres deep! I wondered how this small class of grade 2 students thought that what we do here could impact something so far away? After all, we don't live near the ocean. They quickly informed me that even the garbage we sometimes, so casually toss to the streets in Thorsby can end up on one of these garbage islands, carried by the wind.

In their inital discussions (which didn't yet include the teacher) they hashed out a plan. They decided they could help by cleaning up Thorsby. As they talked amongst themselves they decided that once a month they would head out into the community and pick up trash. But, that it seemed, was not quite good enough! They suddenly became concerned about what they would be putting the trash into, after all, they couldn't use *plastic bags*! Plastic was one of the worst forms of garbage! They decided

they would use reusable, washable bags to pick up the litter around town. And with Mrs. Walker finally being asked if they could do this, it was all set.

They got their reusable bags and 19 pairs of leather gloves (donated generously by Sweet Landscaping!), and headed out on a chilly December day to clean up the Elementary and High School grounds. They were quite astonished (and thouroughly disgusted, I might add) that it took so long because they picked up 10 bags of trash from the High School alone! But they were committed and focused, planning their next clean up to be the block that Kollbrook Esso and Ku's is on, in January.

They have made awareness posters to pin up at both schools, and they welcome anyone who would like to help them to come forward! If you would like a poster for your business or can spare some time to pick up trash with them, please contact Mrs. Walker at the school.

Their message is simple, as Rowan's poster states..."QUIT IT! STOP LITTERING! SAVE THORSBY!"

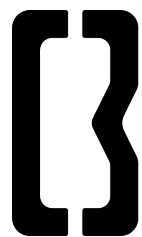

LETTER TO THE EDITOR

I cannot understand why the residents of Thorsby don't attend Council Meetings more often. But, I totally understand however, how extreme cold would make us want to stay indoors and keep warm.

Last week's Council Meeting was a good example, more people could have witnessed the following:

A Councillor, following all the rules of good governance, tried to place an item on the agenda that would call for a bylaw to be ammended (Bylaw 2012-02). This bylaw lays out rules governing the Council Code of Conduct. The ammended bylaw would add to (not revise) the current bylaw. This addition would clarify the non existent rules regarding length of absence from Council Chambers and the use of electronic means to attend meetings when absent.

At present, the only existing policy under the MGA allows a Councillor to miss 8 consecutive meetings to lose Councillor status. However, he or she could attend electronically.

My concern is that a vague and erroneous interpretation does not mean that a Council Member can conveniently forget why he or she was elected in order to spend 6 months on vacation in sunny Arizona, and while he/she is there get the same honorarium as the other Councillors do, less 25%.

In my opinion, a Councillor cannot perform his or her elected duties to 100%, let alone 75% if absent for 1/2 a year.

In a meeting regarding this issue, two Councillors, Deputy Minister Paul Wynnyk, Chief of Staff, Dr. Bill Bewick of Municipal Affairs, and MLA Mark Smith assured the Council members that rules of conduct can be added to the bylaw we already have. So why was Councillor Foster's motion to amend the bylaw summarily refused by the Chair?

Mayor Raymond, in his report to the Thorsby Tar-

get last week said he discussed this problem with residents, some of whom agree, others don't. In my discussions with people, I could only find only one who had no problem with the situation.

When the meeting was about to end, I raised my hand to make a comment. I was totally ignored, and the motion was made to close the meeting.

As stated, the Councillor spends 6 months, less a day, away from the majority of his Council commitments to vacation at his residence in Arizona. When he returns to Thorsby, does he leave again? If he does, then it can be implied that he spends more time in the U.S. then he spends in Thorsby. Would that not make his primary place of residence in Arizona and his vacation home in Thorsby?

I don't know if the residents of Thorsby realize that the taxes paid to maintain and balance the budget, also includes honorariums for Councillors. So, therefore, aren't the residents of Thorsby paying for a Councillor to take a six month vacation?

This Council should realize that when elected they were expected to fulfill 100% of their elected obligations and do what benefits the town.

I would like to see more residents attending these meetings.

My entire childhood was spent on a farm, just outside of Thorsby. My mom and dad took over the Kuzio family farm, and as far back as I can remember, our family spent countless hours fixing fence, repairing and replacing old buildings, picking rocks, renovating, caring for our horses, pigs, cows and chickens, cooking meals and cleaning. It wasn't all work though. My parents always made time for play. Dad loved partaking in horse trips and most sports (hockey, baseball, golf and curling) and mom still continues to be a social butterfly today! I recall many family dinners after church on Sundays, lots of camping trips and late Friday nights at the hockey arena, followed by a party at someone's house afterwards.

I began Kindergarten in the old museum across from where the elementary school is today. My teacher was Audrey Brosseau (Nichols), and I believe it was her first teaching assignment that year. I think the best part of my day is when we all got to snuggle with our blankets and pillows for nap time. My parents still laugh about when I informed Ms. Brosseau that my dad was an artist. It goes to show

how much kids see the greatness in their mom and dads!

I also attempted partaking in high school sports, but I wasn't very strong, so it was short lived. Instead, I moved forward with piano lessons, and ran to keep in shape. I was fortunate enough to maintain a part-time job at Kollers Grocery Store. The best part about my job is when my boss, Carol Koller asked me to drive her Grande Prix to deliver groceries. I loved that car so much, that I aimed to own one one day, and the moment I could afford it, I purchased the same make/model car!

After graduation, I landed a teller position at the Bank of Montreal in Thorsby. When summer came to a close, they helped my relocate to Edmonton and Drayton Valley. As far back as my childhood years, I aspired to be a teacher, but feeling financial pressures, worrying about my grades, surviving in a big school and exploring a new relationship, I put that on hold and stayed in the banking industry. During those 10 years, I married Cory Babcook (from Warburg,) had 2 children and continued my training for a Financial Services Manager. One evening, I was trying to study, and I recall staring at the same page for countless minutes. I reflected on my ultimate goal, and I questioned why I was spending so much time studying something that didn't catch my interest. It was then that I realized I wanted to go back to school, so I enrolled in University part-time. Although not always easy (but thanks to the support of my family, my Auntie Shirley and my mom), I completed my B Ed degree, and substituted, while continuing to raise my children. By the time I finished, I had 5 little ones at home, so life was definitely busy!

My husband Cory and I moved to Warburg in 1998, and still live here today. Cory

(along with his brother and close friend) own High Mark Well Servicing, in Drayton Valley, and I have been teaching full-time at Warburg School since 2010. Although I have lost touch with so many wonderful people, I value my friendships with those near me. We continue to pass through Thorsby on a regular basis, as my parents and sibling both live in the area. We also take in some community events and socials in Thorsby whenever time permits.

I feel blessed to grow up in a small town, and I hope my kids will cherish the positive experiences that I had.

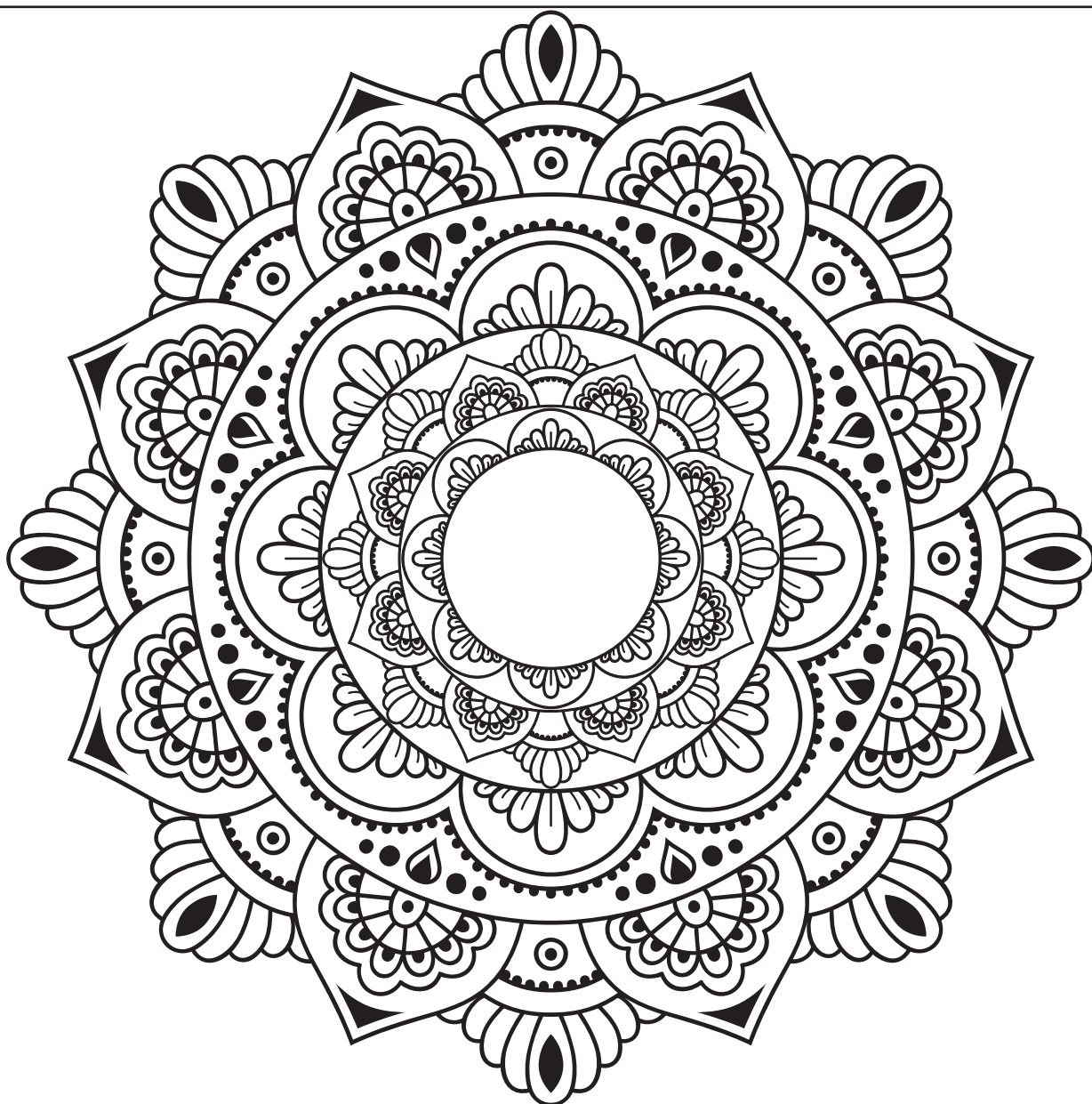

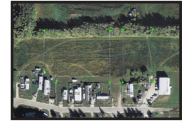

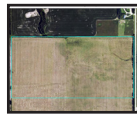
