#### Musical Group SCMR Collective To Perform Black History Event February 23rd

Join the Breton Museum and the Faith Covenant Church as we celebrate Black History Month with an Edmonton based musical group called the Shiloh Centre for Multicultural Roots Collective. SCMR Collective will perform a musical concert starting at 2 p.m. on February 23rd at the Breton Faith Covenant Church.

The SCMR Collective is a talented Edmonton based group, many who have strong ties to the Edmonton Shiloh Baptist Church, who will take us on a musical journey through time. The roots of African American music reach back to the African continent and was brought to the Americans by Africans who were seized and forced into slavery, to work on plantations. Africans who came to the Americas during the slave trade brought many of their African traditions with them, including their music. Plantation music more commonly known as "Work songs" or "Field hollers" were sung by the African American slaves as they toiled at back breaking repetitive labor in the fields, and helped ease the terrible conditions they were forced to bear. From these early songs a variety of musical genres have emerged including gospel music, the blues, jazz and hip-hop. Join us as SCMR Collective take us on this musical journey.

This year marks the 25th anniversary of the

official recognition of Black History Month by the Canadian government, and it was only in 2017 that the Alberta government officially recognized February as Black History Month. Looking back through the Breton museum's records we found that 1994 was the first year the museum celebrated Black History Month. What started as small open houses at the Breton Museum has now grown, and for the last 10 years, thanks to the museum's partnership with the Breton Faith Covenant Church.

To make this event accessible to all, admission to the event is by donation. As part of the event the Breton Museum and Breton Faith Covenant Church will be conducting a food drive of non-perishable items for the Breton Food Bank. So please join us on February 23rd as we celebrate Black History Month.

#### Alberta Health's Coverage for Seniors Program eligibility changes effective March 1, 2020

From Seniors and Housing Client Relations

Alberta Health is changing the eligibility criteria for the Coverage for Seniors program. Effective March 1, 2020, family members younger than 65 years of age—including spouses and dependants—will no longer be covered by Coverage for Seniors. Albertans 65 years of age and older will continue to be covered by the program.

Affected households received letters in January and February 2020 notifying them of the change and available coverage options. Below are some frequently asked questions that might be helpful if you are assisting seniors affected by this change.

When will the Coverage for Seniors change come into effect?

The change in coverage for seniors' family members under 65 will take effect on March 1, 2020. This means a non-senior spouse/ partner and dependants will continue to have coverage until February 29, 2020.

I am a senior and my spouse/partner is also a senior. Does the change mean only one of us can be covered under the Coverage for Seniors plan?

If a senior and spouse/partner are both 65 or older, they are both eligible for the Coverage for Seniors plan.

Please note, however, that a spouse/partner may have been enrolled in Coverage for Seniors, prior to turning 65, as part of a senior household. As eligibility for Coverage for Seniors will be based on age effective March 1, 2020, both seniors must have provided proof of age to maintain their coverage after February 29, 2020.

Seniors who have not yet provided proof of age will need to respond to the letter they received asking them to provide their documents as soon as possible. Visit https://www.alberta.ca/seniors-health-benefits.aspx for more information on how to provide proof of age.

What options are there for family members under 65 who will lose their coverage under the Coverage for Seniors plan on March 1, 2020?

These family members may want to consider options such as an employer-sponsored plan or other private coverage. Alternatively, the Government of Alberta has drug and health benefit programs available to ensure that all Albertans have access to economical health benefits. For more information about these benefits, please visit the Alberta Health website at https://www.alberta.ca/drug-coverage-health-benefits.aspx.

One of the government-sponsored options is the Non-Group Coverage program, administered by Alberta Blue Cross. The Non-Group Coverage program has the identical drug formulary as the Coverage for Seniors plan, and does not preclude patients with pre-existing conditions. Any Albertan who is no longer covered as a result of changes to the Coverage for Seniors Plan will be eligible for coverage under the Non-Group Program. The Non-Group Coverage program requires its members to pay monthly premiums and copayments on prescriptions.
