Hello Community Members – As this is being written there is much uncertainty and concern on what our community, province and world will look like in the days to come. I am sure even by the time you are reading this, things may have changed some. The Village of Breton is taking the current COVID-19 pandemic seriously, and actively monitoring the situation, as well implementing directives from authorities at Alberta Health Services and the Province. The health and wellness of our residents and visitors remains of the utmost importance, and the Village is taking every precaution to promote prevention. Additionally, we are closely monitoring all information from the provincial authorities and will be heeding all actions recommended to mitigate the impact of the virus in our community. Updates will continue to be provided to the public as necessary.

While there is an understandable level of concern surrounding the pandemic, the risk level in Breton remains low, and we will continue to monitor and follow all mandates from the Province and Alberta Health Services. 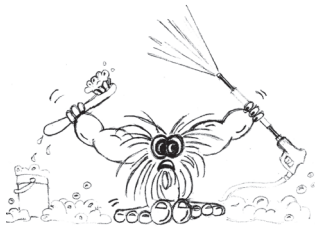

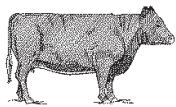

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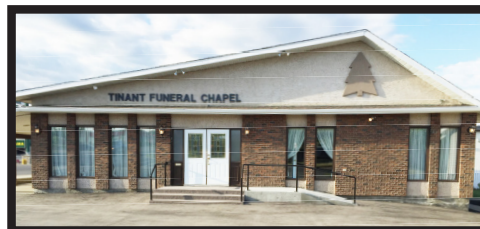
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COVID-19 INFORMATION

ALBERTA RECOMMENDATION FOR MASS GATHERINGS

DEFINITION: For the purposes of this document, a mass gathering is any event or assembling that brings together people in a single room or single space at the same time, such as an auditorium, stadium, arena, large conference room, meeting hall, cafeteria, theater, or any other confined indoor or confined outdoor space. **Update: As of March 15, this definition includes places of worship.**

At this time, this definition does not include normal operations at airports, shopping malls, recreation centers, libraries, casinos, typical office environments or retail or grocery stores or other spaces people may be moving or walking about as part of normal activities of daily living. We encourage businesses to ensure patrons are aware of the risk and ensure enhanced cleaning protocols are in place.



Mass gatherings with **more than 250 people** should be cancelled.



Mass gatherings with **less than 250 people but more than 50** should be assessed by the event hosts/organizers/planners and cancelled if they meet any of the following criteria:

- event includes any number of attendees coming from countries outside of Canada
- event has, as its focus, attendees that are members of critical infrastructure or critical service roles (e.g. healthcare workers, first responders, electric/power workers, telecommunications)
- event includes attendees from demographic groups at greater risk of severe disease, such as people 60 years of age and older and individuals with chronic medical conditions
- will attendees be participating in activities that promote transmission (e.g. singing, cheering, close physical contact such as when participating in contact sports, sharing food or beverages, buffet style meals)

If the event does not meet any of the above criteria and the event will proceed, event hosts/organizers/planners shall follow the general risk mitigation strategies listed in the green box below.



All events of **50 people or less** and all events that are proceeding because they do not meet the criteria in the yellow box above shall follow these general risk mitigation strategies:

- Clarify that individuals who are sick with a fever or cough should not attend (even if symptoms appear to be mild or resembling a cold);
- Recommend that anyone at high-risk of severe disease not attend the event;
- Reduce the number of participants or change the venue to prevent crowding;
- Stagger the time of arrivals and departures;
- Provide packaged refreshments instead of a buffet;
- Increase access to handwashing stations;
- Frequently clean surfaces that are touched often;
- Promote personal protective practices (hand hygiene, respiratory etiquette, staying home if ill); (note; would be good to have a link to that info here)
- Offer virtual or live-streamed activities instead of in-person events; and
- Change the event program to remove activities that increase the risk of disease transmission such as those that require physical contact between participants.

COVID-19 SELF-ASSESSMENT

Use this self-assessment tool to help determine whether you should be tested for COVID-19. You can complete this assessment for yourself or on behalf of someone else, if they are not able.

Testing is currently focused on individuals who have traveled outside Canada or had contact with someone diagnosed as having COVID-19, or have developed symptoms of COVID-19.

Travellers returning to Alberta on or after March 12th: ALL travellers who returned to Alberta from outside Canada on or after March 12th are required to self-isolate immediately, for 14 days, and monitor for symptoms. Travellers who returned to Alberta before March 12th:

Travellers who returned to Alberta from Italy, Iran, the Hubei Province of China or the Grande Princess Cruise ship, before March 12th, must also self-isolate, and must monitor themselves for symptoms for 14 days after return. If symptoms do develop, stay home and call 811 immediately. Travellers who returned to Alberta from other destinations outside Canada, before March 12th, are encouraged to self-isolate, and monitor themselves for symptoms.

If you have symptoms:

Anyone who has symptoms, including cough, runny nose, fever or sore throat, must also self-isolate for 14 days.

Please do not visit a hospital, physician's office, lab or healthcare facility without consulting Health Link (811) first.

If you need immediate medical attention, call 911 and advise them that you may have COVID-19.

To protect yourself while out in public, wash your hands frequently, and maintain a distance of about 2 metres from others.

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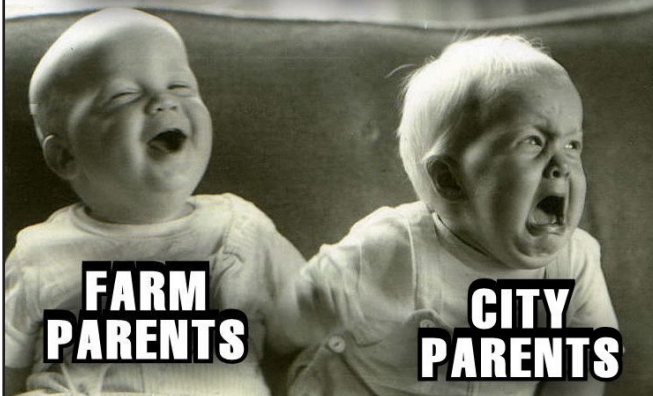

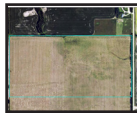
