
Open Farm Days Information Session







FRASER (THE ENFORCER) FILIPIC Part 2 of 2

And what advice would Fraser give to those wishing to achieve his level of fistic prowess, especially when you are on the smaller side in a league where there are very few under six feet tall? "I just try to get in close and get a couple of good shots in before they get their arm loose. Against bigger guys you've got to get inside or you're pretty much done". Joe Blaznek the talented forward for the Wichita Thunder said of Fraser during the 2005-2006 season: "You gotta respect a guy like that because he knows he might have to fight every night — I wouldn't want to do that. Fighting is a skill and he does it really well. He's not even that big of a guy but he is willing to go with anybody".

A newspaper of the day (2006) reported that: "It's important to note that Filipic is not a notalent goon. He has chipped in forty points so far this season including eight power-play goals and four game-winning goals". To this Fraser replied, "I've been getting a lot of ice time, some time on the power play. The bounces are going my way this year". Regarding his role as an enforcer he says, "it's a good stress reliever; you can take your frustrations out. It keeps you out of trouble". At the time, Fraser's room-mate was Greg Pankewicz, a Drayton Valley product, who led the Eagles in scoring

and had a cup of coffee in the NHL with the Calgary Flames.

During the off-season Fraser worked as a rigger for Westower Communications out of Thorsby. In the basement of the Filipic family home he had both a heavy bag and a speed bag and followed the regimen of the boxer faithfully. He commented that, "It seems to be working. It keeps my hand speed up there pretty good".

On Sept.17, 2010 the Colorado Eagles issued a news release:

EAGLES FIGHTING FORWARD, FILIPIC, RETIRES

The Colorado press ran the following: Windsor, Colorado. The Colorado Eagles announced today that the first player signed by the franchise, Fraser Filipic, is retiring. The forward was best known for his fisticuffs – including two knockout fights on home ice during his seven seasons in Northern Colorado.

"It's not easy seeing Fraser step away from the game", said team president, General manager and head coach, Chris Stewart, "but his body has taken quite a toll in recent years and I understand and respect his decision. I'll miss his friendship personally, and our team will miss his toughness and tenacity on the ice. He was a true professional who brought his best to the rink every night".

The 5'9', 182 lb. pugilist retires as the franchise all-time leader in penalty minutes with 1,464 (only one other player in team history has more than 1,000 – Greg Pankewicz's 1,130). The majority of Filipic's penalty minutes came as a consequence of his 122 career fights.

Today Fraser is a settled and content familyman. He has a daughter (Saylor) and a son (Darko – named after Fraser's older brother) and three step-daughters (Mackenzee, Adalyn, and Kinleigh). While Fraser is away working for Precision Drilling in the Wyoming oil patch,

wife Trischa runs the family household as well as her own property management company in Severance, Colorado, just east of Fort Collins. He holds dual citizenship and recently spent a week, along with son Darko at the home of Marjan and Diane in Leduc. Fraser looks back fondly on his career in hockey, remembering his team-mates, the fans and the places he got to see.

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






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
