Village Of Warburg Update

From Mayor Kevin Maine

How the world has become smaller in a few short weeks. The conversations have changed from climate change, pipelines, and roadblocks to COVID-19.

Personally, on a daily basis I see our residents struggling with our new reality. I believe it has a lot to do with the unknown. Do I have it? Have I passed it on to a loved one? How bad will it affect me? Most of us will get COVID-19 in some form.

Go to the Alberta Health Services website when you are looking for up-to-date information. The website has a self-evaluation test and instructions on what to do. If you have symptoms call Health Link (811) but expect a wait time. Don't go to the hospital. All the measures that the province have put in place is to slow the spread so that the medical system doesn't get overwhelmed.

The Village has closed the hall, arena, curling rink and library. We have also closed the village office to the public. Both the village staff and public works will continue to work to ensure that essential services stay in place. We have split our office and public works staff. Public Works will be working opposite weeks so that if we get COVID-19 in a staff member we have a backup staff member to continue. You will still be able to call the office (780-848-2841) and FCSS (780-848-2828) for information and emergencies.

The Easter egg hunt and the volunteer appreciation night have been cancelled. We will be updating the

village website and social media as things change. We thank you for your patience in this troubled time.

I have lived in this community for the last ten years and have been involved on several boards. I have witnessed a large volunteer group organize events and do random acts of kindness. I have seen citizens work behind the scenes and do great things. In the coming weeks and months I expect this will continue. If you have a neighbour that has self-isolated, reach out with a text or a phone call. Not all people will ask for help when they need it.

Here below I have listed some advice, tips and instructions.

- 1) Limit going out to only essential outings - otherwise stay home.
- 2) When out - practice social distancing - this means keeping 1-2m distance from others in public social settings. Avoid touching / shaking hands. A wave will do.
- 3) Upon return home, wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- 4) Avoid touching your face, mouth and nose areas.
- 5) Cover up sneezes /cough with your sleeve or elbow or tissue.
- 6) If you are feeling ill, but not seriously ill, with ANY respiratory illness (cold like symptoms, fever or cough), review yourself by going on the online Alberta Health Assessment Tool (or by contacting Health Link by dialing 811) before going to a doctor's office or walk-in clinic. Health Link can inform you if you need to be tested for COVID-19, even if you don't have a travel or exposure history. 8) Travel is not advised outside of Canada. Countries are closing borders making return travel unpredictable.

9) If you have recently travelled or you have plans to travel outside of Canada, you must self-isolate yourself at home for 14 days after your trip to monitor for symptoms. The Alberta government has listed flights that were at higher risk of exposure of COVID-19. If you have travelled in the last 2 weeks, please check this document here: <https://www.alberta.ca/assets/documents/covid-19-flight-information.pdf>

10) For those of you with more complex medication issues, or if you are over the age of 65, you are more vulnerable to complications from COVID-19. Please take extra precautions to protect yourself, such as diligent hand hygiene precautions, avoiding large groups of people, avoiding travel and avoiding anyone who may be ill, including family members. If you are under 65 and healthy, your risk is less but it is certainly not zero, so please take appropriate precautions for yourself as well. Being overly cautious now is better than under prepared later.

Alberta RCMP provides update on detachment services amidst COVID-19 spread

March 18, 2020

Effective immediately, Alberta RCMP detachments will be modifying service delivery at front counters and restricting access to public spaces within RCMP facilities. Signage will be displayed at all exterior public entrances reflecting the following:

- In order to prioritize essential policing services and to reduce unnecessary contact with personnel, detachments will suspend all non-critical front counter services. Fingerprinting for Criminal Record Checks will only be done in exceptional circumstances. Non-urgent fingerprinting and Criminal Record Checks will resume at a later date.

- Before proceeding to a detachment, please consult our provincial directory and phone the listed telephone number (<http://www.rcmp-grc.gc.ca/detach/en/find/AB#wb-cont>). If assistance can be provided to you over the phone, an employee or officer will do so. If your request requires personal contact with an officer, that decision will be made over the phone.

- The decision to limit public contact in non-urgent situations was made to ensure the health of the public and our employees so that we are able sustain essential services across Alberta.

- Please dial 911 only in an emergency.

- Our Operational Communication Centres are open and fully functional for all emergency calls.

"A number of changes have been put in place to protect the health of our employees and the public. These decisions were made to ensure that there were no impacts to essential services, keeping our communities safe," said Deputy Commissioner Curtis Zablocki, Commanding Officer of the Alberta RCMP. "As Alberta's provincial police service, we have sound business continuity plans in place to ensure Albertans can continue to count on us every day, including during times of public health emergencies."

Leduc County cancels all public programs and events in response to COVID-19

March 18, 2020

This afternoon, Leduc County announced that all county-hosted public programs and events, including council and committee meetings, will be cancelled until further notice in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In addition, public access to all Leduc County administrative buildings has been restricted for the safety of both staff and residents.

"These decisions are in line with health authorities' recommendations to practice social distancing and avoid time spent in crowded spaces," says Leduc County Mayor Tanni Doblanko. "The health and safety of our residents and our employees is our priority. We recognize that the situation is changing on a daily basis, which is challenging for all of us; but we are in this together and are doing our best to keep everyone safe during this unprecedented time."

At this time, Leduc County's operations and emergency services' response levels remain intact.

On March 11, the county activated its Emergency Coordination Centre (ECC) to coordinate resources and information, and ensure that essential services continue to operate.

ECC staff are consistently reviewing the information being released by Alberta Health Services and the federal and provincial governments to inform decision making and actions related to the effects of the situation on Leduc County.

Mass gathering restrictions

Last updated: March 17 at 4 pm

From Albert.ca

New public health measures are now recommended to limit the time Albertans spend in large crowds and crowded spaces. Effective March 17:

Mass gatherings are now limited to no more than 50 attendees.

This includes: conferences, worship gatherings and family events such as weddings and funerals.

This does not include: grocery stores, shopping centres, health care facilities, airports, the legislature and other essential services.

Albertans are prohibited from attending public recreation facilities and private entertainment facilities.

This includes gyms, swimming pools, arenas, science centres, museums, art galleries, libraries, community centres, children's play centres, casinos, racing entertainment centres and bingo halls.

Albertans are prohibited from attending bars and nightclubs, where minors are prohibited by law.

Sit-down restaurants, cafes, coffee shops, food courts and other food-serving facilities, including those with minors-allowed liquor license, are limited to 50% capacity to a maximum of 50 people.

Take-out, delivery or drive-through service is permitted.

Licensed facilities are permitted to deliver liquor (PDF, 112 KB)

Not-for-profit community kitchens, soup kitchens and religious kitchens are exempt at this time, but sanitization practices are expected to be in place and support will be in place for this practice.

Effective March 18, all passenger ropeways, like gondolas and chairlifts will be closed until further notice under the Safety Codes Act.

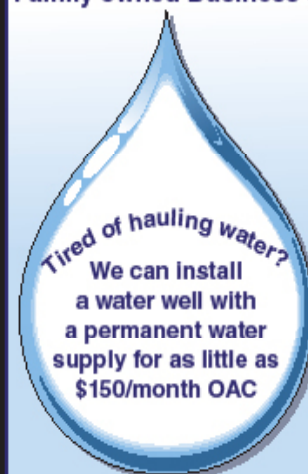

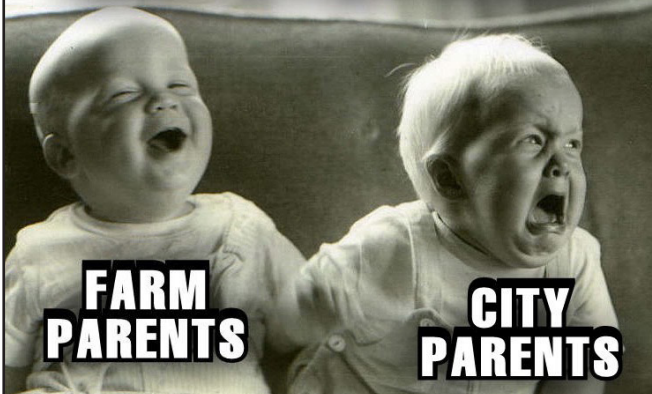

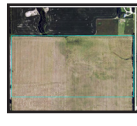
