### THS Grads and the Old West

From John Elson

Pastor Jeff Gooderham, in his Covenant Corner column (The Target, Mar.20) introduced us to an outlaw who has added much to the romance of the Old West. This was Black Bart, a stagecoach robber operating mainly in California and Idaho from 1875 onwards. His exploits (if that is the correct word) set the tone perfectly for a happening in another part of the Old West that has lived on in legend for close to 140 years. The site is Tombstone, AZ. In the not too distant past four intrepid grads of THS set out for Tombstone to discern what the fuss was about at the OK Corral. But first let's take Pastor Gooderham's findings a little further.

The Pastor, in explaining Biblical approaches to dealing with the emotional concept of fear, shows Black Bart to be the very personification of evil, haunting the Wells Fargo stage lines and being the perpetrator of at least 29 robberies His misdeeds were carried out during the same period of history that blood was being shed in Arizona.


Black Bart's real name was Bole or Boles and he was born in an obscure corner of the United Kingdom. He appears in California during the gold rush as a gold-panning prospector, then

later in the Civil War on the Union side. Having come to the conclusion that robbery was the best way to get ahead he carefully charted out the roads, times and likely chance of profit in the area directly north of San Francisco. He did not exactly fit the role of the quick- drawing and trigger happy gunmen we will later meet in Tombstone. Like some of those he was a big talker but considered more gentlemanly than the majority of the ruffians at the OK Corral. Pastor Gooderham points out that he never fired a shot. He carried out his robberies on foot as he was deathly afraid of horses. He would appear from behind a tree or cactus, armed with a shotgun, and, standing well back from the horses would say, "Throw down the box". This done, the stage would be waved on. On at least two occasions he wrote poems of celebration and handed them in at the door of the stage before retreating. The poems, though amusing, might be found offensive to the more gentile among us, so will not be reproduced here. To make a long story short, he was eventually caught, did time, and appeared back in California. He was last seen in Visalia, CA. in late February 1888 but left no trace. His disappearance is a complete mystery and myths, tall tales and even ghost stories abounded at the time. One such story had it that he was killed by a shotgun rider whom he had once robbed, another that on turbulent nights in the Bay area, near Alcatraz, he will appear as a zombie with a blood-soaked rag covering one eye. On such occasions he will say nothing. Another belief was that he fled to Canada to be reincarnated from time-to-time as a school superintendent. In these instances he attempts evil but disappears before he can carry out his malicious intent. In Mexico, at midnight on the "Day of the Dead" the laughter of his intended victims can be heard. In any event he was never seen, in the flesh, again.

Such a colourful story of the American West leads us directly to what our THS grads found when they visited Tombstone at least 138 years after the famous shoot-out. The title will be "In Search of Wyatt Earp".

### **MOUNTAIN PINE BEETLE UPDATE**






Introduction: Last summer (2019) the Throsby area from the westerly direction and experienced an inflight of mountain pine beetles (MPB) Dendroctonus ponderosae. This winter we have been told there is some trees that have been infected by the MPB. This insect is the most destructive insect pest of the lodgepole pine forest. It is expected that emergence will take place within the next couple of months and a new brood will continue its flight eastward.

What Can You Do?: Alberta Agriculture and Forestry recommends the removal of all pine trees with over 40 pitch tubes. When the MPB population approaches the maximum that the tree can support, the beetles in the tree release a pheromone called verbenone to repel newly arriving beetles. Verbenone can be synthetically produced and acts as an anti-aggregation pheromone which sends the message "No Vacancy".

tree between June 15 and July 1st.

**Effectiveness:** Verbenone has shown to be effective at low to moderate beetle population pressure and is not very effective when the pressure is high. Whether you value your pines as landscape trees or for shelterbelt protection you may want to make the investment to attempt to protect your trees this summer.



### Update COVID-19 Pandemic in Alberta

(April 1 at 5:00 p.m. From Alberta.ca)

Since March 31, an additional 117 cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in Alberta, bringing the total number of cases in the province to 871. There have been two additional deaths.

Cases have been identified in all zones across the province:

527 cases in the Calgary zone 219 cases in the Edmonton zone 57 cases in the Central zone 51 cases in the North zone

12 cases in the South zone Five cases in zones yet to be

Five cases in zones yet to be confirmed. Of these cases, there are currently 29 people in hospital, with 13 admitted to intensive care units (ICU). In total, there have been 62 hospitalizations, with 20 admissions to ICUs. Ninety-four of the 871 cases are suspected of being community acquired. There are now a total of 142 confirmed recovered cases.

All Albertans need to work together to help prevent the spread and overcome COVID-19. Restrictions remain in place for close-contact businesses, dine-in restaurants and non-essential retail services. A full list of restrictions is available online.

Albertans are prohibited from attending gatherings of more than 15 people, and they must continue to observe two metres of social distancing. This includes events both indoors and outdoors, such as family gatherings, weddings and funerals. Further details are available online.

### Update on special event licences

As a result of the limitation of mass gatherings to a maximum of 15 people, AGLC has temporarily suspended the special event licensing application process on its website.

People who had planned to host private events and had already purchased special event licences may apply for refunds by emailing sel@ aglc.ca or visiting aglc.ca for more information.

### Access to justice

The Court of Queen's Bench is encouraging Albertans to access alternative dispute resolution mechanisms for non-urgent matters, including mediation and arbitration.
