Leduc County announces 2020 tax payment postponement

March 27, 2020 This afternoon, Leduc County council announced a postponement of 2020 tax payments and the cancellation of tax and utility payment penalties.

The 2020 property tax payment deadline has been postponed from June 30, 2020 to Sept. 30, 2020. Property tax notices will be mailed out in May. As well, penalties for tax payments, water, wastewater and solid waste utility payments, and bulk water accounts payments have been cancelled. These changes are in effect from March 27 to Sept. 30, 2020.

Update COVID-19 Pandemic in Alberta

(April 1 at 5:00 p.m. From Alberta.ca)

Since March 31, an additional 117 cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in Alberta, bringing the total number of cases in the province to 871. There have been two additional deaths.

Cases have been identified in all zones across the province:

527 cases in the Calgary zone

219 cases in the Edmonton zone

57 cases in the Central zone

51 cases in the North zone

12 cases in the South zone

Five cases in zones yet to be confirmed. Of these cases, there are currently 29 people in hospital, with 13 admitted to intensive care units (ICU). In total, there have been 62 hospitalizations, with 20 admissions to ICUs. Ninety-four of the 871 cases are suspected of being community acquired. There are now a total of 142 confirmed recovered cases.

All Albertans need to work together to help prevent the spread and overcome COVID-19. Restrictions remain in place for close-contact businesses, dine-in restaurants and non-essential retail services. A full list of restrictions is available online.

Albertans are prohibited from attending gatherings of more than 15 people, and they must continue to observe two metres of social distancing. This includes events both indoors and outdoors, such as family gatherings, weddings and funerals. Further details are available online.

Update on special event licences

As a result of the limitation of mass gatherings to a maximum of 15 people, AGLC has temporarily suspended the special event licensing

application process on its website.

People who had planned to host private events and had already purchased special event licences may apply for refunds by emailing sel@aglc.ca or visiting aglc.ca for more information.

Access to justice

The Court of Queen's Bench is encouraging Albertans to access alternative dispute resolution mechanisms for non-urgent matters, including mediation and arbitration. The next step for your RRSP is ...

You're turning 71 by the end of 2020 and you know you have some important Registered Retirement Savings Plan (RRSP) decisions coming up. Let's look at the best options for preserving your retirement income and your estate.

The background You established an RRSP back in the day and contributed to it for many years. Good for you - an RRSP is the best tax-saving, income-building investment vehicle for most Canadians and is undoubtedly an important part of your retirement income. But if you turn 71 this year, you are required by law to wind down your RRSP before the end of 2020. You have three basic conversion options to choose from.

Cash out your plan Not a good choice - you'll likely be taxed on the total amount right away at a high marginal rate.

Establish a Registered Retirement Income Fund (RRIF) RRIFs are very much like RRSPs with two exceptions: No further contributions are allowed once you've established a RRIF and you are required to withdraw a minimum amount each year.

The mandatory minimum RRIF withdrawal is 5.28% for a 71-year-old and increases as you get older. There is no limit on the maximum amount you can withdraw although you won't want to deplete your RRIF too soon.

If you find you don't need all the withdrawn funds, you can contribute your RRIF payouts to a Tax-Free Savings Account (TFSA) or a non-registered investment account.

Purchase an annuity There are many types of annuities. Here are three:

- A "life annuity" pays you a specified income, usually monthly, for the rest of your life.
- A "term certain annuity" guarantees payments until you turn 90.
- A "joint and last survivor annuity" will continue payments to your spouse after your death. (But with this option, your monthly payments will be reduced because the benefits are paying for two lives not one. Your spouse can receive the same amount you receive or a lesser amount of your choice).

The right RRSP conversion option for you depends on your personal situation - that's why you should talk to your professional financial advisor before you take the next step.

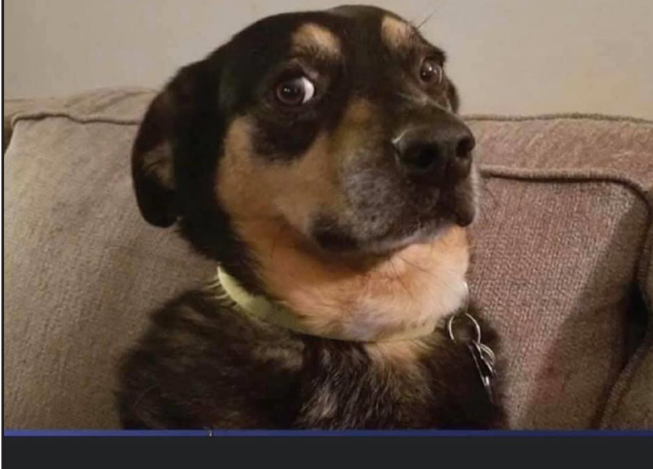

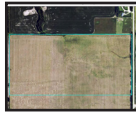
