As I sit here watching the sun come up, I reflect about all the good things in life. I think about my relationships, especially with my life partner, who tolerates me. I consider myself fortunate to live in this country, this province, and this town. I, like many others, wonder and worry about what the future holds. I look out the window onto the potholes on Hankin and it snaps me back to the job at hand. We do have a lot of issues regarding roads and water. The guys at public work's, work tirelessly to keep the town's infrastructure functioning. The rain and snow last week caused a lot of issues. It is the first time I had water running through my door sill into my shop. Like previous town councils, we will continue developing the master plan to make this a better community.


Please help us keep the water moving in the right direction by not blowing your grass clippings into the street or dumping them in drainage ditches, or pumping your sump into back lanes. It all adds to the strain on our infrastructure, causing blockages in catch basins or adding to the frost heave issue and making back lanes into mud holes.

Ongoing work continues on the budget, which entails costs and services. We see a few savings, resulting from the Covid19 shut down. We still have to run the water treatment plant, we still have to fix streets, we still have to work on water drainage issues and we still have to cut the grass. We continue to run short staffed in the town office, to which I thank Marianne and Christine. We still need to run the town, to which we still need property taxes and water bills to be paid. We have around 25% of property taxes paid by mortgage holders and another 25% pay by monthly installments. We encourage everyone to pay monthly, to lessen the shock of a once a year payment. We are looking at the penalty portion of the property tax bylaw. Town council is considering changes, to reduce penalties resulting from late payments, if and only if, there is a payment plan in place. To put it another way, if you are having problems, paying taxes, or water bills, please don't leave it until you are in too deep before making arrangements with the town office. Ignoring the problem will not make it go away, but only make it worse. As the saying goes: "at the end of the day, you still have to pay".

We are looking at ways to reduce the price for water, which will benefit every resident, businessowner, homeowner, and renter. The thought is, if we can reduce the amount we charge for a cube of water, larger consumers (large households or business's) it should lower monthly costs. It improves the possibility of commercial sales as well. Another option is charging the water and sewer infrastructure fees to vacant lot holders. We must maintain the infrastructure, so vacant lot owners should be paying for the infrastructure, along their lot frontage as well. We are looking at amendments to the land use bylaw, for granny suites, multiple resident buildings on a single lot, tiny homes, tiny homes with RV garages for snowbirds, AirBnB suites, etc. The discussion includes both residential and commercial lots. If we are going to add extra cost to vacant lot, landowners, we need to give them flexibility to build on them. We need to give flexibility to existing homeowners, who wish to build a small granny flat to get their parents out of senior housing, or adult children out of the house: LOL. There is a lot of work to be done in defining options and rules. plus public consultation.

Lastly, let's have some fun this weekend. While our normal May Long Weekend events can't occur, let's spread some smiles and have some family fun. Get the kids involved decorating your vehicle and join in the socially distanced, "6 Feet Apart, 2gether in Heart" parade. We have great community spirit in Thorsby, so let's show it.

Staging will start at the Farm Centre and our local RCMP detachment will lead the parade starting at around noon, it may take a while to tour as many streets as possible, so keep a look out and listen for the honkin' of horns and watch from the safety of your yard or from the window. Let's have some fun. Due to **COVID-19** The Thorsby Haymaker Rodeo 2020 has been **CANCELLED**. The Board of Directors made a hard decision, but it is based on the situation surrounding the **COVID-19** pandemic. Stay safe and we will be looking forward to seeing you in 2021! LETTER TO THE EDITOR

CIB / Barry Rasch, can your decision to disrupt our peace of home and mind be validated with facts and figures and a good sustainable plan for the future?

Is CIB Thorsby a one man show or is there an organization or committee involved (outside of the realm of town Council)? If so, how many members are there, are there any ratepayers as members?

We, who pay taxes have a vested interest in how our tax dollars are spent.

Where are the minutes from the meeting that took place regarding trails? What measures were taken to engage the townspeople in conversation on this topic, before the CIB's decision to go ahead with the project? Does the CIB decision trump those of the rate payers? Who's the dog, who's the tail?

Funding for CIB comes from Alberta Parks and Recreation grants. These monies come from Provincial tax dollars. Yes, it is our tax dollars given to CIB. Should we not all have a say where our dollars are spent?

Barry, please share your balance sheet with us, as well as a treasurer's report. Can CIB afford the trails? Can you maintain the trails, provide lighting (monthly bill), provide security to the 10 properties affected? WE ARE NOT THE LION'S PARK, we are a residential street. Can you provide public liability (post Use at own Risk signs does not stop lawsuits or injury)? What is your fire safety plan, wood chips and cigarette butts don't mix? Picnic tables cry vandalism. It was two local older adults that felt they had the right to deface the Complex playground with rude and vulgar graffiti. We do not want such activities in our yards. Will CIB keep tables in good repair and will you be cleaning up after the walkers and bike riders? Where will the people park their vehicles? Do you have a concrete plan or will parking take place in front of our homes? (With a short cut through our yards).

I ask, has CIB the funds in place to care for and maintain the trails for years or is this a whim and the town will have another white elephant on the books?

Without these questions being answered and concerns dealt with, is Barry Rasch a good steward of the government grants handed to CIB Thorsby? Will you respond to the concerns and questions with facts and figures of your project? Are we again going to be bulldozed farther into the quagmire of where our tax dollars are being spent by who and on what? Will our voices and rights be over-ruled by the wants of a handful of elected people, along with a person who has no interest in the ramifications of his actions put forth on others?

Part 2

The following letter submitted to the Target has been sent via registered mail to the town office, with a copy to each councillor. I have been notified that other forms of communications will not be acknowledged by council.

On April 3rd, 2020, the Target; Message from the Mayor - "Having 4 other like minded, intelligent, <u>FISCALLY</u> responsible people on council is the 5th small town advantage."

May 1st, 2020, the Target; Barry Rasch states that Thorsby CIB and the Town of Thorsby will partner up to develop and create an addition to the Network of Trails. CIB will provide the budget while the town will supply access.

At which council meeting was this discussed and decided on? Were the minutes posted to the public? Were the ratepayers asked for input on this? Did just the 5 councillors and Barry approve of spending our taxpayer dollars?

Yes, I can email all inquiries, complaints, thumbs up I want but technology has advanced to include a delete button in our lives. We do not need to share or make public what we don't want, or like them to hear.

I prefer that all citizens of Thorsby have equal opportunity to hear my views, good and bad, on decisions made by the town council. We bought our property based on what we wanted, not what the town council and Barry wanted. Older neighborhood, stable neighbors, quiet, peaceful, private, wildlife in backyard, green space, song birds, frogs, rabbits, are what we enjoy. We respect our neighbors, their properties and privacy. Safety not an issue, we watch out for each other.

Now, CIB Barry Rasch and town council have planned behind our backs to disrupt our peaceful quality of home and property. Yes, they are inviting one and all to our back yards, with no regard to our safety, the safety of our property. There will be those that respect us, but those that don't, won't. It matters not to 6 men who don't care who's looking in our back window.

Transparency of those elected to office should always be the first mandate when making decisions on where to spend our money. You have been elected to office and you are being paid to serve us and take measures to upkeep and protect our assets and environment. To fulfill your duties of position which we entrusted in you to do. We do not give you a blank slate to do what you want with our tax dollar. To spend wantonly is not good fiscal judgement.

Local Artist Shares Some Light




