



As our province continues to see success in containing COVID-19 and reopening the economy, it is time to look to the future. On June 29, our government announced an ambitious Economic Recovery Plan. Focused on creating jobs, building up our province, and diversifying the economy for the future, this plan introduces new measures and investments that will help get Albertans back to work.

As part of Alberta's Economic Recovery Plan, our government is investing in infrastructure projects which will create tens of thousands of jobs in the near term, and fuel prosperity for years to come. In total, the Recovery Plan is expected to create 50,000 jobs, many of which will be related to the construction and maintenance of Alberta's critical infrastructure. This funding will help businesses who have lost a significant portion of their revenues reopen safely, and help get Albertans back to work.
