# Counselling Subsidies

Starting in September, Breton and Area FCSS is pleased to offer Counselling Subsidies.

A subsidy is available for individuals, couples and/or families who are struggling with common, everyday issues to access short-term preventative counselling services. The goal is to:

- Improve relationships with better communication and conflict resolution skills
- Improve mood with anger management and emotional support
- Enhance personal growth with creativity, spirituality, self-esteem, self-awareness, goal setting
- Improve parenting skills by focusing on attachment
- Reduce stress with life balance; and/or
- Learn new skills and behaviors

The cost of counselling can be a barrier for many individuals and families. This subsidy is available to those who do not have access to coverage through health benefits or employee benefits, such as an Employee Assistance Plan (EAP), and whose family income is less than \$75,000 per year. Fees are determined according to a sliding scale based on income and family size. Fees range from \$15 per session to \$55 per session. The maximum number of sessions available is seven for individuals and nine for couples or families.

Counselling services are provided through a partnership with Karunia Counselling from Leduc.

We know that in this current environment many may have additional stress and anxiety. We also know that transportation may be an added barrier. These sessions can be arranged to be in person in the Karunia offices in Leduc, over the phone in your own safe environment or virtually on your computer.

To apply for the subsidy services, application forms are available through the Breton FCSS Office at 4916 50th Avenue or by contacting them at fcss@breton.ca or calling 780-696-3636.

Breton and Area FCSS will be doing the intake of the applications. Counselling services are provided by Karunia Counselling by Registered Psychologists, Registered Provisional Psychologists, Canadian Certified Counsellors and Masters or PhD level student interns under the supervision of a qualified psychologist. All applications will be kept in strict confidence. This program is being made available through funding from the Government of Canada's Emergency Support Fund, the Drayton Valley Community Foundation and Breton and Area FCSS.



#### Dear Editor:

Since it is now common knowledge that the Kenney government intends to "write down" the "linear tax" on pipelines, it is time to react.

I understand this means that Mr. Kenney doesn't intend to collect the tax AT ALL. It will therefore be another tax break for oil and gas.

Given that he has already provided a \$4.7 billion tax break to them, it looks a little excessive to say the least. Every municipality/jurisdiction in the province will suffer from this move, especially when added to the downloading already imposed; e.g., policing costs and other grant reductions.

Since this linear tax represents about 85 percent of County revenue, this means a drastic cut that will have to be made up elsewhere; i.e., increase in property tax and/or reduction of services.




