Thorsby RCMP Seek Assistance in Stolen Hot Tub Incident

Thorsby, Alta. – The RCMP are investigating the theft of seven Arctic Spas Hot tubs from a manufacturing site in Thorsby. Public assistance is being sought from anyone who has information, either about the stolen spas or the truck involved.

On Sept. 2 at 9:00 a.m., a transport truck with a false name loaded the seven spas without legal authority. The truck was identified by the driver as: 10036218 Canada Inc. Transport Pascal Charland out of Chateaugay, QC.

The truck is described as a white Volvo semi truck

with no company markings, equipped with a bunk/sleeper. The trailer was a flat deck, newer looking. The driver is described as:

- Caucasian male
- 30-40 years of age
- Approximately 5'6" tall / heavy build
- Short brown hair and unshaven

The Arctic Spas stolen were models: Ocean, Totem, Yukon, Aurora, Tundra (x2) and Fox.



LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

Dear Editor:

The citizens of Brazeau County appear to have been duped. Consider the following:

Our Council in their infinite wisdom have voted (4-3) to spend several million dollars on an aquatic centre. Not too long ago, it was policy to have any expenditure over \$2 million go to plebiscite. That policy has since been rescinded—Example One of removal of public concern, interest, and input.

About 10 years ago, the pool project was determined NOT to be a good idea. The public had some input at that time.

This time, public input was not offered. The big question is why was a “special meeting” called to pass a motion to contribute to the pool project (after a 40-minute unnecessary in camera session) when a meeting with the Town to join the project was the very next day. This does not seem to be a coincidence—Example Two of removal of public concern, input, and interest.

Who is responsible for council agendas? Why were these meetings scheduled in such a way that the public couldn't have any input before decisions were made?

Does not the whole of Council have the responsibility in determining the timing and content of agendas? Why was the public not informed if there were any meetings prior to the one on August 24 that passed the motion?

Who calls “special meetings” and who sets the agenda? Is this not normally the job of the Reeve? Should not the content of these “special meetings” be made known to the public in a timely fashion?

Dealing with the Town is also problematic. The County made a contribution to the construction of

the Omniplex. The County also makes a \$1.3 million contribution to the operation of recreational facilities in Drayton Valley (presumably for one-half of operation costs). Do the residents of the County want the Town to run this new facility? Example Three of removal of public concern, interest, and input.

So much for looking after the needs, interest and/or concerns of the citizens who pay Council's way. What happened to the stated objective of Council transparency (September 1 agenda, p.2).

As of this writing, a special meeting is ongoing with only “invitees” allowed to attend. Why are the rest of us cut out? Whose interests are being looked after when a meeting is for select invitees and not the public?

So much for transparency and accountability.



The cost of counselling can be a barrier for many individuals and families. This subsidy is available to those who do not have access to coverage through health benefits or employee benefits, such as an Employee Assistance Plan (EAP), and whose family income is less than \$75,000 per year. Fees are determined according to a sliding scale based on income and family size. Fees range from \$15 per session to \$55 per session. The maximum number of sessions available is seven for individuals and nine for couples or families. Counselling services are provided through a partnership with Karunia Counselling from Leduc.

We know that in this current environment many may have additional stress and anxiety. We also know that transportation may be an added barrier. These sessions can be arranged to be in person in the Karunia offices in Leduc, over the phone in your own safe environment or virtually on your computer.

To apply for the subsidy services, application forms are available through the Breton FCSS

Office at 4916 50th Avenue or by contacting them at fcss@breton.ca or calling 780-696-3636. ALL APPLICATIONS ARE STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL Breton and Area FCSS will be doing the intake of the applications. Counseling services are provided by Karunia Counseling by Registered Psychologists, Registered Provisional Psychologists, Canadian Certified Counsellors and Masters or PhD level student interns under the supervision of a qualified psychologist. All applications will be kept in strict confidence. This program is being made available through funding from the Government of Canada's Emergency Support Fund, the Drayton Valley Community Foundation and Breton and Area FCSS.
