

Thorsby Council Invests in Community Economic Development

From the Town of Thorsby

After months of research, interviews, surveys and community consultations, recommendations were presented to Council on Tuesday October 13, 2020 to action the economic development and marketing strategic plans. The work was completed through the Central Alberta Economic Partnership (CAEP) with funding from the Government of Alberta Coal Transition Funding. The overarching objective of the work is to build Thorsby's capacity in economic development. Many activities were presented while others like a workforce strategy and methods to speed up and simplify municipal processes, have already been completed.

The presentation prioritized the recommended actions for economic development and marketing, following final feedback from the open house held the previous week. The purpose was to illustrate how Thorsby Council could action ideas to create a big impact using a variety of strategies and tactics with the available funds. Council discussed importance of balancing the Town's need for infrastructure and economic development guided by a long-term plan that can bring about transformational change in the Town over the short and long term. The consultants stressed that Thorsby has significant assets including a skilled workforce, the rail line, industrial land, housing, employment, recreational facilities, proximity to Edmonton, and Highway 2 as well as the YEG International airport, and a popular lake nearby. They also highlighted the enthusiastic community members who have expressed interest in being involved in this community & economic development work.

The focus for the plan, therefore, is generating awareness of the opportunities in Thorsby and providing infor-

mation to businesses, developers and visitors who may want to invest, live, or do business in the Town.

The economic strategies include updating land use policies, infrastructure planning, regional collaboration, developing a housing strategy, boosting community pride, and cleaning and fixing up properties. A Team Thorsby strategy and a First Impressions Community Exchange program were also suggested, where Thorsby would twin with a similar-sized community to give fresh eyes to each others' challenges and opportunities.

It was recommended the Town hire an experienced, part-time or contract, economic development officer to facilitate these strategies and apply for grants to maintain ongoing service and further implement the action plan past grant funds.

To support the economic objectives and create awareness about Thorsby, the proposed marketing strategies include increasing the online presence for the Town and its businesses as well as on-site signage, a roadside kiosk, and informational material that will attract passersby to visit and support the local economy.

One of the first marketing activities will be the redesign of the Thorsby.ca website to include visitor information and economic development opportunities. As well, content featuring community assets will be produced and an education session for businesses to increase their internet presence will be offered. Information about how community members, groups and businesses can get involved will be posted on the Thorsby Facebook page, website and in future editions of Target.

The group also shared some resources about possible grants that could support Town economic development activities, tourism, broadband and other infrastructure. In a motion, Council unanimously approved the recommended actions as presented, allowing work to proceed.

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2020-2021 School Re-entry Plan From BGSD

Updates provide clarity on quarantine guidelines, locker use, and more

Nisku, Alberta (October 20, 2020) - The public is advised that Black Gold School Division has updated its 2020-2021 School Re-entry Plan to include additional information from Alberta Health Services.

The re-entry plan, updated October 19, 2020, includes updated information, highlighted in yellow, on the following topics:

- Quarantine and Isolation guidelines (pages 3-4)
- Additional information on Cohorts (page 7)
- Locker use in schools (page 11)
- Diploma Exams update (page 13)

The Division remains committed to updating our plan as needed in response to changes directed by Alberta Education. Any changes in the implemented school re-entry scenario will be determined by Alberta Education and Alberta Health Services with information on local school-based and zone information. We remain in communication with the Alberta Government and will continue to follow its advice.

The Province has stated that its decision to allow in-school learning with public health measures in place weighs the risks of prolonged school closures on students' educational experience and overall well being against the risk of COVID-19 outbreaks.

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
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
