

Winnifred (Winnie) May Lansdell, age 97, passed peacefully October 28, 2020 at Breton Long Term Care with her children by her side.

She was born December 11, 1922 to Earl and Helen Barnes in the Clive area. She married Norris Lansdell on December 27, 1945 who preceded her in death in 2003. Winnifred loved growing up on the farm at Clive. She helped her Dad in the fields and milked cows. She finished Grade 11 in Tees, then spent time in Red Deer and in Lethbridge working in the hospitals there.

After she married Norris they farmed and worked in Central Alberta.

Winnifred and Norris took up residence in Breton in 1955.

She was known in the community for her delicious homemade bread and buns which she offered for sale from her living room window on main street in the 1950's. She was a ward aide at the Breton Hospital in its first years starting in 1963. For a long time she held down three jobs, cleaning the Breton Elementary School, the Treasury Branch and the Post Office. She was always a hard worker and enjoyed her work so much... a freshly washed and polished hallway in the school gave her much joy as did interacting with the students as they came and went. She never complained about getting up in the cold of winter and shovelling the walks at the school before the rest of the town woke up.

Winnie was a cornerstone of the Breton United Church Women and took pleasure in hosting meetings at her home which always included a beautiful spread of tea and sweets. In 1986 she retired and enjoyed various camping trips which took her as far north as Alaska and into BC and Saskatchewan. These camping trips often included grandchildren. Her greatest joy was her family, especially when they were all gathered around the table, enjoying her great meals and her delicious desserts. Love and laughter was always plentiful. Even in her last days when she was physically unable to go visiting, her first question was always "How are the kids?" She took comfort in hearing everyone was doing well.

Winnifred leaves to celebrate her life and carry on her legacy: daughter Patricia Denholm (David) of Stettler; son Larry Lansdell (Fiona) of Leduc; daughter Michele Bevan (Randy) of Breton; 8 grandchildren; 22 greatgrandchildren and 2 great great grandsons. She was the second eldest of 11 children.

She is predeceased by her parents, 4 brothers and 2 sisters. She leaves 3 sisters, 1 brother and numerous nieces and nephews to enjoy memories of good times together.





What is God's Will Concerning Healing?

Are you wondering whether or not God wants *you* to be healed? This question is not new; someone in the Bible also wondered the same thing. Matthew 8:1-3, "When he (Jesus) was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him. And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, 'Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean'. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, 'I will; be thou clean'. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed." Now notice, the leper was wondering if Jesus was willing to heal him, and Jesus said, "I am willing" and then he healed the leper. If God will do something for one person, he will do it for all. Romans 2:11, "For there is no respect of persons with God." It is God's will that the leper be healed and healthy and it is His will that EVERYBODY throughout all ages be healed and healthy. If God was ever willing for one person, HE IS ALWAYS WILLING FOR ALL. Hebrews 13:8, "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever." And Malachi 3:6, "For I am the Lord, I change not; ..."

Luke 9:11, "And the people, when they knew it (where Jesus went), followed him: and he received them, and spake unto them of the kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing. If you read on in Luke chapter 9, you will see that there were *five thousand people* in that crowd. Jesus healed those that needed healing. It does not say that Jesus only healed those who had enough faith, or those who were doing everything just right and had everything working for them, or those who were free from sin, **But** those that needed healing. It is not possible that every person in that crowd who needed healing had everything working right for them. God was not choosing who got it and who did not. If someone needed healing, Jesus healed them.

John 12:49-50, "For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak." Jesus is saying that whatever he says is what the Father wants him to say. ("The Father" is God).

Jesus told us how to pray in what is commonly called The Lord's Prayer. In a portion of the prayer he said, Matthew 6:10, "Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven." Notice, Jesus said to pray that God's will would be done in earth just like it is in heaven. What is it like in God's kingdom? Well, Jesus gave us a clue when he sent out the seventy. Luke 10:9, "And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you." And also when Jesus sent out the twelve disciples in Matthew 10:7-8, "And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give." As we can see from these two verses, in heaven and in the kingdom of God there is freedom from sickness and disease. God's will is done in heaven and everybody in heaven is healed and healthy. Let's read that verse again, "Thy Kingdom come. THY WILL BE DONE IN EARTH, AS IT IS IN HEAVEN." Jesus said to pray that God's will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Nobody is sick in heaven so it is God's will that EVERYBODY ON EARTH BE PERFECTLY HEALED AND HEALTHY!!! Remember, God NEVER, EVER changes, if he is willing to heal one, he is willing to heal all, and that includes YOU.






