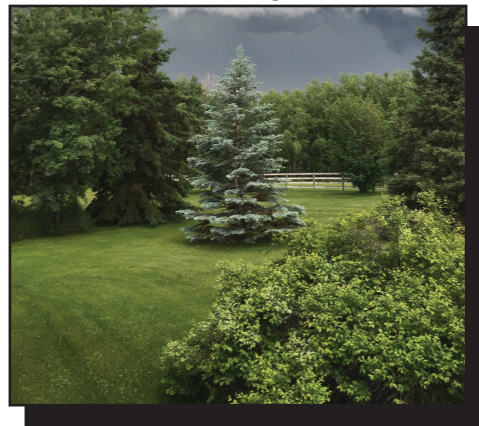

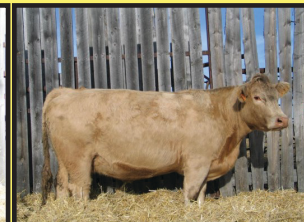

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MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

From Mayor Rod Raymond

With the first snow storm of winter now under our belts, we've been reminded of what we have to look forward to weather wise for the next six months or so, we can compare notes with Covid 19. That first wave has been and gone, but we now have other waves to follow, just like our winter snowfalls.

With confirmed cases in Town, now is the time to be the best Canadians we can be and prepare for the next six months or so of Covid, just like we pack our toques, boots, shovels and the all important chocolate bar (just in case) in the trunk of the car before we set off from home, lets add masks and hand sanitizer to the list and put them on wherever we go..... to the store, the gas station, the post office, grandma's house etc. Christmas is just around the corner, so let's all do our part so we can hopefully change the direction on the curve that we all get to see and hear about every day in the news.

As we head towards the end of the year, budget deliberations are at the forefront and Council knows that it will be especially difficult as we go into 2021 with many hard choices to make. Indications from the Province lead us to believe that there will be reduced grant funding available which may impact our ability to continue infrastructure replacement at the speed we would like; We're also faced with increased policing costs from the Province, up to \$28,957 from this year's \$19,291, and which are projected to be at \$57,913 by 2023. Council will continue to work hard to deliver a final budget that protects essential services to the community and meets our provincial obligations, however after two years of no increases and a reduction in tax revenues this year, it would be less than honest if we didn't let you know that it is unlikely that we will be able to hold this line.

Lastly, to end on a positive note, AHS were very happy with our protocols at the Rec Centre last week when they conducted an unannounced inspection. Shout out to Kristen and her team for ensuring sufficient protocols are in place and be-

ing followed. The rec complex will also be hosting a Christmas Market on November 21st, so please put on your masks and support the local vendors taking part in the event.

UPDATED SNOWPLOW SERVICES FOR RESIDENTS

As per policy PG-04: Snow Clearing Private Driveways, Leduc County will provide snow clearing services on private driveways, as requested by county residents, up to three times per season free of charge. All additional snow clearing services will be invoiced at the end of the season as per Leduc County's fees and charges bylaw.

At the Oct. 13 council meeting, council approved updates to the policy, which include the following changes:

- Leduc County staff will no longer open or close gates to gain access to residents' driveways.
 - Gates must be left open if you would like to access private driveway snow clearing services.
- Summer grading will no longer be offered.

New private driveway snowplow agreement

With these updates in place, residents will need to sign a new private driveway snowplow agreement. Once you have submitted a new agreement, you may request snowplow services. Agreements are available online at **www.leduc-county.com/winter-operations**.

How to request snowplow services

After you have filled out a private driveway snowplow agreement, you can request snowplow services by email, phone or through an online application form, as follows:

- Email your request to **snow@leduc-county.com**
- Call **780-955-7226** and follow the prompts
 - Note: if you call to request snowplow services, your call will not be returned.
- Fill out an online snowplow services request form at **www.leduc-county.com/winter-operations**

Remember to include your first and last name, municipal address and phone number in all of your requests.

Please note: after you submit a request for snowplow services, you will be placed on a list for driveway clearing.

When are driveways cleared?

As per policy PG-03: Snow Clearing County Roads, snowplowing for private driveways will take place after Leduc County roads are deemed to be in an acceptable condition.

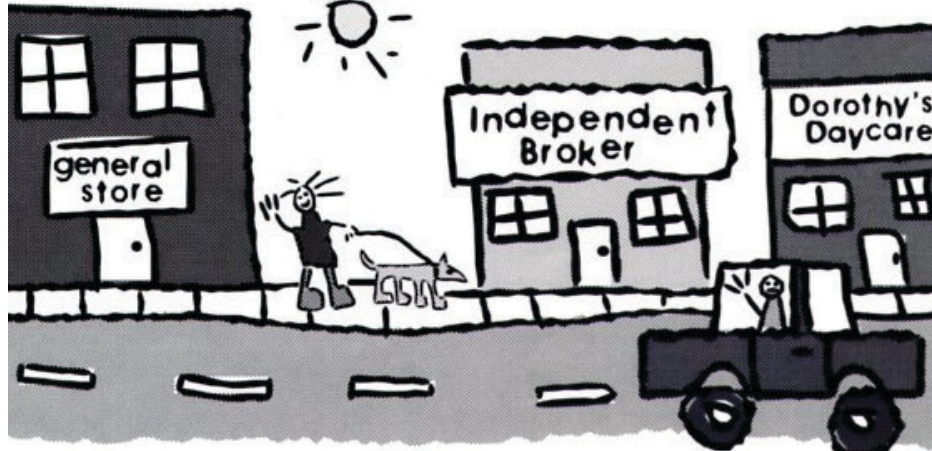
You Have Been Named The Beneficiary

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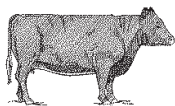
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
