SUPPORTING RURAL MENTAL HEALTH

This past year has been a challenge. A global pandemic, economic uncertainties, financial stress and changes to our everyday routines has been a lot to deal with and can result in increased stress and feeling overwhelmed. An important step in mental health is watching out for each other. Sometimes it can be hard to know what to do, and you may not be aware of the resources available that can help.

Signs that someone may need help:

- consistently expressing sadness or hopelessness
- unable to concentrate or focus
- constantly exhausted
- unusual irritability

How you can help:

- Ask the person what they need
- Ask if they have someone they can talk to, such as a friend, spouse or doctor
- Use the tips listed under reducing stigma
- Contact Leduc County FCSS to learn more

What is stigma?*

Stigma is when someone views you in a negative way because you have a distinguishing characteristic or personal trait that's thought to be, or actually is, a disadvantage (a negative stereotype). *information from MayoClinic.org

How to reduce stigma:*

- ▶ Treat everyone with respect.
- ► Be warm, caring and non-judgmental.
- ► Challenge stigma when you see it.
- Watch your language.

- Learn the facts about mental health and mental illness.
- ► Help raise awareness about mental health.

Impacts of vaping on youth in the Leduc region
