

Is Seeing Believing?

What is faith? Is it seeing, sensing, feeling, or hearing what we prayed for? If someone says, "I believed with all my heart that such and such would happen on this day, and on that day I did NOT SEE IT, so I guess it wasn't God's will." Is this FAITH? No! How can it be? The Bible says in 2 Corinthians 5:7, 'For we walk by FAITH, and NOT BY SIGHT.' Also, in Hebrews 11:1 it says 'Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things NOT SEEN.' Jesus tells us plainly what real faith is in Mark 11:22-23 'And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.' Look at Numbers 23:19 'God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? Or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?'. Faith is having confidence in God that he will do what he says in his Word, and acting on his Word. Likewise, we can believe and declare anything else that he has promised us, such as healing, provision, peace, strength, protection, etc. We just simply take him at his Word, and pay no attention to what our senses tell us. When it comes to faith, we must believe BEFORE what we prayed for comes to pass, knowing that it will.

How do we get this kind of faith? In Romans 10:17 it says: 'So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.' Why by the Word? Because Jesus is the Word and God has made his will known to us in his Word. John 1:1 'In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:14 'And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.' Therefore, we cannot truly know God if we do not read the Bible. John 15:7 'If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.' True faith in God is trusting God, and having assurance that he will do what he says he will do or has done, despite what we see in the natural. 




