# Community Volunteer Income Tax Program

#### - FREE INCOME TAX PREPERATION -

For low income persons, families, seniors and students. We will begin taking information for tax season on March 1. Although this is something that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2020 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for.

The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families and students. The program is available with those with the following approximate income.

	2 person family	37,000
-	3 person family	40,500
٠	4 person family	43,500

We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources: Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1,000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information

and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30-4:00. Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 1-April 30, 2021

We require the following information in order to complete your return:

Personal Information (Social Insurance Number, Birth date, Marital Status, Address)

Dependant's information – spouse/children's names, birthdates.

All "T" Slips (T4's, T4A, OAS etc.)

All Forms, Schedules, and Labels you have received from Revenue Canada.

Receipts for any expenses such as medical, moving, tuition, sporting activities. Printouts from your pharmacist are available for those with numerous prescriptions.

Previous year's tax return if available





# LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

Dear Editor:

Just a few thoughts for Brazeau County taxpayers to consider.

According to the Ag Service Board (ASB) minutes of January 20, 2021, a listing of spray rebate recipients was made. The following approximate amounts should be noted:

In 2018, \$16000 was paid out at 30% of cost; in 2019, \$47000 was paid out at 60% of cost; in 2020, \$37000 was paid out at 60% of cost.

The largest amount paid to an applicant in 2018 was about \$2700; in 2019, about \$9300, and in 2020, close to \$8000.

This information raises a number of questions:

- a. If you spend this kind of money just for noxious weeds, would there be a better way to control them?
- b. The Weed Control Act specifies that the landowner is responsible for weed control.
- c. Why is the public paying farmers to meet their own responsibility?
- d. Why are recipients' names not published as this rebate is public money, donated by a public institution (Council) to follow a public law for the public benefit?
- e. Why is there a discrepancy between the total number of recipients (125) and the number of pay outs (150) for the three years? No explanation was given in the minutes.
- f. Is it possible that this program is fostering bad habits?

By analogy, if I wish to drive a vehicle, I must follow the rules. If I don't, nobody pays for 60% of my tickets (e.g., speeding). Why then should the public pay for someone else's weed control?

# World Day of Prayer From Ebeline Zee-Hawtin

This year the World Day of Prayer is scheduled for Friday, 5th of March, 2021. Normally the service would have been held at St. Matthew's Lutheran Church in Thorsby, but with the gathering restrictions that is not possible. However, a service has been made available by the Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada and is available as a video on their web site. It can be viewed on www.wicc.org from now until September.

This year the host country is the Republic of Vanuata, a small country of islands located in the South Pacific Ocean north-east of Australia. Its black and white sandy beaches, coral reefs with coloured fish, tropical birds, fruits and nuts, make the islands a pristine environment, even though they are vulnerable to frequent earthquakes, cyclones and active volcanoes. Melanesian people, along with Polynesian, are the primary source of Vanuata's culture and languages. The Republic was formed in 1980 from a French and British joint government. Today, Vanuata proudly waves its flag and its coat of arms which reads "In God we Stand." The theme for this year is "Build on a Strong Foundation."

The World Day of Prayer is a global ecumenical movement which brings Christians of many traditions together to observe a common day of prayer each year. Through preparation and participation in the worship service, we can learn how our sisters of other countries, languages and cultures understand the Biblical passages in their context. We can hear their concerns and needs and can join in solidarity with them as we pray with and for them. In this way, it is possible to enrich our Christian faith as it grows deeper and broader in an international, ecumenical expression.


The motto of the World Day of Prayer movement is Informed Prayer and Prayerful Action. Through our participation in the World Day of Prayer, we affirm that prayer and action are inseparable and that both have immeasurable influence on the world.

The World Day of Prayer traces its roots to the 19th century when Presbyterian women in the United

States called for a national day of prayer in 1887, and Anglican women in Canada established a national day of corporate intercessions for mission in 1895. In 1922, the Canadian and U.S. committees agreed to use the same theme and day for the Day of Prayer as U.S. women. This annual event became the Women's World Day of Prayer in 1927; in recent years it has been named World Day of Prayer although Women's Committees in the host countries continue to prepare the service to be used throughout the world. The Canadian committee is the Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada (WICC) and now includes representatives from 11 church partners. The WICC also distributes grants up to \$5,000 to fund social justice community projects.


