Dear Editor:

An Open Letter to Jason Kenney,
Recently when asked about your government's planned cuts you replied, "Money does not grow on trees. ... We have to protect the health of the province's finances."

I was flabbergasted hearing this from a premier who lost \$1.3 Billion gambling on a failed pipeline, spent \$12 million to dismantle the Super Lab (which would have been useful during the pandemic) and \$1.5 million to cancel oil by rail contracts. Corporate Tax Cuts that benefit corporations will amount to \$4.7 billion in lost revenue and the embarrassing so-called 'war room' has a budget of \$30 million.

It is obvious that your cuts have nothing to do with austerity but are about your hidden agenda, the one you did not campaign on. It includes decimating our public health and education systems in favour of American style privatization that will cost more and cater to the wealthy, dumbing down our post-secondary education system and breaking our unions in favour of big corporations who donated to your campaign.

Please don't use the pandemic as an excuse for your financial mismanagement of my tax dollars. Under your watch it had already ballooned pre-pandemic.

You have squandered Albertans' tax dollars as if they grew on trees. You must step down because you are not representing the best interest of Alberta and Albertans.





Community Volunteer Income Tax Program
 – FREE INCOME TAX PREPERATION - For Low Income Persons, Families, seniors and students. We will begin taking information for tax season on March 1. Although this is something, that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2020 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families and students. If your income was in one of the following categories you may qualify for assistance.

- 1 person 30,000
- 2 person family 37,000
- 3 person family 40,500
- 4 person family 43,500

We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources:

Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1, 000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30 – 4:00. Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 1 – April 30, 2021

We require the following information in order to complete your return:

Personal Information (Social Insurance Number, Birth date, Marital Status, Address)
 Dependant’s information – spouse/ children’s names, birthdates.

All “T” Slips (T4’s, T4A, OAS ect.)

All Forms, Schedules, and Labels you have received from Revenue Canada.

Receipts for any expenses such as medical, moving, tuition, sporting activities. Printouts from your pharmacist are available for those with numerous prescriptions.

Previous year’s tax returns

Counselling Subsidies – Fully paid subsidies until March 31. Breton and Area FCSS is pleased to offer Counselling Subsidies.

A subsidy is available for individuals, couples and/or families who are struggling with common, everyday issues to access short-term preventative counselling services. The goal is to:

- o Improve relationships with better communication and conflict resolution skills;
- o Improve mood with anger management and emotional support;
- o Enhance personal growth with creativity, spirituality, self-esteem, self-awareness, goal setting;
- o Improve parenting skills by focusing on attachment;
- o Reduce stress with life balance; and/or
- o Learn new skills and behaviors

The cost of counselling can be a barrier for many individuals and families. This subsidy is available to those who do not have access to coverage through health benefits or employee benefits, such as an Employee Assistance Plan (EAP), and whose family income is less than \$75,000 per year. Fees are determined according to a sliding scale based on income and family size. Fees normally range from \$15 per session to \$50 per session but all fees will be covered for appointments held before March 31. The maximum number of sessions available is seven for individuals and nine for couples or families. Counselling services are provided through a partnership with Karunia

Counselling from Leduc. We know that in this current environment many may have additional stress and anxiety. We also know that transportation may be an added barrier. These sessions can be arranged to be in person in the Karunia offices in Leduc, over the phone in your own safe environment or virtually on your computer. To apply for the subsidy services, application forms are available through the Breton FCSS Office at 4916 50th Avenue or by contacting them at fcss@breton.ca or calling 780-696-3636. ALL APPLICATIONS ARE STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL. Breton and Area FCSS will be doing the intake of the applications. Counselling services are provided by Karunia Counselling by Registered Psychologists, Registered Provisional Psychologists, Canadian Certified Counsellors and Masters or PhD level student interns under the supervision of a qualified psychologist. All applications will be kept in strict confidence. This program is being made available through funding from the Government of Canada's Emergency Support Fund, the Drayton Valley Community Foundation and Breton and Area FCSS.

Online Course – Home Alone – aimed at youth 10 and older to learn skills to be Home Alone for short periods of time. - \$10

Home Support Services – light household cleaning services to those that require assistance due to mobility, injury, age. Rates are income based

Roar of the Rings on Pigeon Lake

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought out creativity in the most surprising ways. As fall trudged into winter, Grandview Beach (south side of Pigeon Lake, near Lakedell) resident Corey Kozack realized that there was a need in his community and he used his creativity to fill it.

Building skating rinks on Pigeon Lake is a long standing tradition for those living along its shores, but with the current situation keeping everyone a lot closer to home for the winter, Mr. Kozack realized that these rinks were leaving out a large segment of the community - seniors. Corey decided to remedy this situation and his solution was to build a curling rink on the lake. Not being a curler himself, Corey had a lot to learn about the process but with a little help from the internet and the community, he was able to create something special. He soon enlisted the help of friend and neighbour, Darcie Carey, to bring the vision to life.

Curlers know that ice is arguably the most important element of the sport. Quality ice for curling is even more important than that for skating or hockey and, fortunately, this year has been relatively successful for ice forming on the lake. Despite the superior conditions, Corey still regularly floods the sheet and heads out to refresh the pebbling on a routine basis to maintain a good surface.

The sheet truly has been a community effort with Crystal Springs resident Gloria Olson offering the use of a set of rocks for use by the players. Her rocks even include one signed by Alberta curling legend, Kevin Martin. Additionally, Loretta Wisenberger has made some homemade 'rocks' out of coloured water frozen in milk jugs for younger curlers to try their hand

at sliding out of the hack. Scoring sticks were made to ensure the competitive curlers can keep track of their progress. Originally straw bales were set out to offer a place to take a rest between ends, but thanks to a generous donation from Lakeside Custom Woodwork, wooden benches are now installed. Neighbours from the area take turns shoveling both the sheet of curling ice and the nearby skating rink, making this a real community project. There is also a firepit available for use at Grandview Park so people can make a day of their experience out on the lake.

The 150 foot by 15 foot sheet of ice can be booked by reaching out to Corey on Facebook or calling him at 780-868-1475, and he has people coming out well into March, provided the conditions hold. Prior to each booking, Mr. Kozack and Mr. Carey prepare the ice by spraying water to refresh the critical pebbles for a good game. They also sanitize all the rocks and set them out for use. At the completion of the booking, the rocks are again sanitized to comply with all COVID restrictions. Those using the ice are asked to observe the restrictions as well, and to make sure they are being respectful of the natural environment by taking out anything they bring in at the end of their time on the ice.

Corey has been very pleased with the response to his project. Users of the ice have ranged from teenagers to octogenarians and everyone in between. He has learned plenty over the course of this season and is already planning on making this an ongoing feature next to the Grandview skating rink, which he has also been involved with maintaining over the past several years. Mr. Kozack is a very community minded person. He is also involved in creating the Haunted Barn during Halloween and organizing the Sledz and Treadz Fundraising Rally taking place on February 27. He hopes that everyone gets a chance to try their hand on the roaring rings before they melt!

Working Parents Benefit

Alberta's government is focused on protecting lives and livelihoods and that means being there for hard-working parents. Between now and March 31, eligible families can apply for the Working Parents Benefit, which will return \$108 million back into the pockets of Alberta families who use childcare or preschool.

The pandemic and the economic downturn have created significant stress for working parents, many of whom have continued to fuel Alberta's economy and provide essential services through extremely challenging circumstances. As a result, fewer families have used childcare this year. As a result, Children's Services is returning unused funds directly into the pockets of families who need it most through this new program.

The Working Parents Benefit is a one-time benefit of \$561 per child. Families who have a household income of up to \$100,000 and who have paid for three months of childcare between April 1, 2020 and Dec 31, 2020, including licensed or unlicensed daycares, day homes, out of school care or preschool, are eligible to apply.

This new benefit adds to supports that Alberta's government is providing to protect the lives and livelihoods of Albertans. It builds upon the recently announced Critical Worker Benefit, which is a \$1,200 payment for eligible front-line and essential workers, and the Enhanced COVID Business Benefit, which provides support for businesses that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

To apply for the Working Parents Benefit, you must have a MyAlberta Digital ID. If you do not already have one, you can easily sign up for an account at account.alberta.ca. After you submit your application for the benefit, you will receive a confirmation e-mail within 24 hours. After your application is pro-

cessed, you will also receive an e-mail informing you if you have been approved, or if more information is required to determine your eligibility.

Alberta's government is working to directly support parents and families who are facing additional stresses due to the pandemic and economic uncertainty. The Working Parents Benefit returns money directly into the pockets of Albertans to help assist them with financial pressures they may have faced throughout the past year.

Alberta's government is responding to the COVID-19 pandemic by protecting lives and livelihoods with precise measures to stop the spread of COVID-19, sustain small businesses and protect Alberta's healthcare system.




