LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

Dear Editor;

Further to my evaluation of the per diem slips of Brazeau County Councillors in 2019, the following observations could be noted.

The use of acronyms is overdone. While other councillors may know what they mean, it is not the other councillors who pay to have these sheets done. The public pays the per diems and are entitled to know what and where our councillors are claiming funds. Is this not what we pay them about \$1400 per month (Reeve \$1800) for?

The Reeve attended an FCM(?) conference, location not named, for three days. Three issues arise. Why were no receipts provided for the meal expenses claimed? Why was no written report as to the presentations given and their value (if any) to our county? If there is little or no value to us (the county), why do you go? Again, the public pays for these conferences and (by county bylaw) we are entitled to such reports. This conference cost the taxpayers a total of \$4300 plus mileage for the Reeve alone. An additional claim that was not categorized on this sheet nor receipted was \$807.32. What was this for as Mr. Guyon came home on June 5, but the conference was over on June 2.

Two other councillors went to this conference as well at similar costs to the county. Figures given do not include the "entry" fees for the conference.

Conclusions:

What is the value to the County of these conferences?
What can a Quebec municipality or any of the provinces offer Alberta as they operate under their rules and we under the Municipal Government Act of Alberta?
Why do we send people who cannot/will not submit written report (as per our rules)?

The solutions are simple:

- (a) if you are not able or willing to write a report—don't go;
- (b) send only those who can or will report;
- (c) don't send anyone to these national conferences;
- (d) resign so we can elect someone who will follow the rules.

Dear Jason Kenney,

You have proven yourself to be an expert at slashing and cutting regardless of financial cost and human ramifications. You spent \$12 million to dismantle the Super Lab and lost at least \$1.5 million to cancel oil by rail contracts. You didn't blink an eye when you cut services for special needs children, opioid dependent patients and seniors.

You defunded medical services for women, ditched the NDP \$25 a day childcare program, closed Norquest campuses in Drayton Valley and Whitecourt and recently you arbitrarily shut down the government of Alberta Library. Your extreme post-secondary cuts will completely strip the University of Alberta of its reputation of a world class institution.

Recently you stated that the 'most important job of an MLA is 'to represent his or her constituents'. Over 70 percent of Albertans have made it abundantly clear that they are vehemently opposed to coal mining in our mountains. Yet you have only given lip service to our demands. You did not rescind the coal leases granted during the past nine months and six exploration projects that were previously approved are moving ahead. Over a million acres along the eastern slopes of the Canadian Rockies remain open to coal mining and exploration. Roads are being cut into the wilderness and test mines dug into the mountains, rendering some of these areas off limits to public use. But you reassure us that you plan to hold public consultations. How much clearer can we be? **COAL MINING IN THE ROCKIES IS UNACCEPTABLE TO THE MAJORITY OF YOUR CONSTITUENTS.** It is time to quit gaslighting, do your job by representing Albertans and shut down ALL activity related to coal mining.

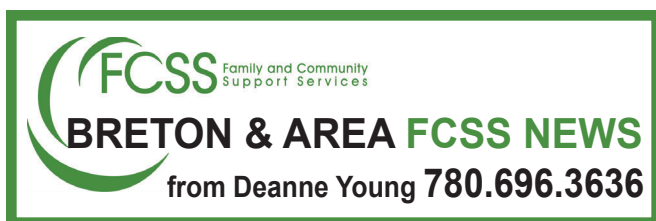

Community Volunteer Income Tax Program – FREE INCOME TAX PREPERATION

- For Low Income Persons, Families, seniors and students. We will begin taking information for tax season on March 1. Although this is something, that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2020 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families and students. If your income was in one of the following categories you may qualify for assistance.

· 1 person	30,000
· 2 person family	37,000
· 3 person family	40,500
· 4 person family	43,500

We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources:

Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1,000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30 – 4:00. Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 1 – April 30, 2021

We require the following information in order to complete your return:

Personal Information (Social Insurance Number, Birth date, Marital Status, Address)

Dependant's information – spouse/ children's names, birthdates.

All "T" Slips (T4's, T4A, OAS ect.)

All Forms, Schedules, and Labels you have received from Revenue Canada.

Receipts for any expenses such as medical, moving, tuition, sporting activities. Printouts from your pharmacist are available for those with numerous prescriptions.

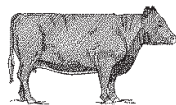

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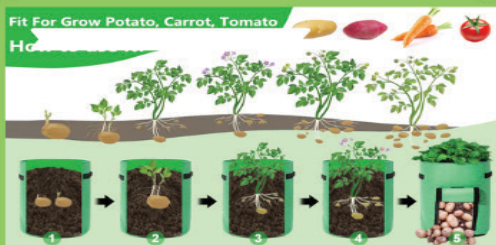

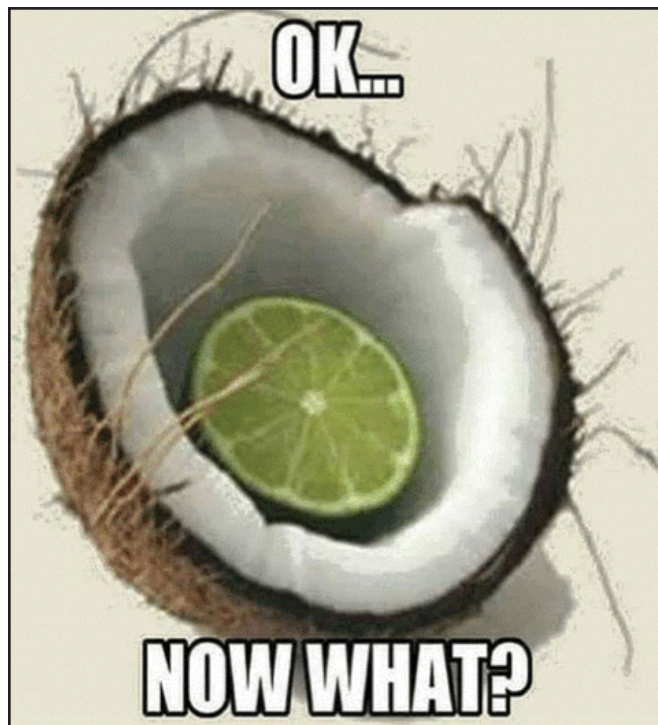
