If you are an agricultural producer planning to haul grain or other agricultural commodities, you must get a permit if your load weights will be in excess of the restrictions.

Call RoaData at **1-888-444-9288** to obtain a road ban exemption permit for agriculture. Please call a minimum of 24 hours in advance of a planned move to ensure conditions allow for it.

## **Secure your cargo**

As a driver, you are responsible for making sure the cargo you are carrying is secured to your vehicle.

- ▶ Use tie-down straps to properly secure objects.
- ▶ Place light objects lower in the container instead of on the top, to prevent them from exiting the container.
- ▶ Tie large items, like mattresses and construction equipment, directly to your vehicle with appropriate tie-down straps.
- ▶ Put loose items, like garbage and yard waste, in a covered container so they are easier to secure.
- ▶ Attach a safety flag to any items that extend beyond the back of your vehicle so they are more visible to other motorists.
- ▶ Place a tarp over loose items or those that billow in the wind to ensure they don't fall from your vehicle.
- ▶ If you are transporting earth, sand, gravel or other loose material, it must be at least 75 millimetres below the top of the container or your truck's box, and must be completely covered at all times.

The proposed bylaw applies to properties in hamlets, subdivisions and other identified areas. The proposed bylaw **does not** apply to agricultural, farming, commercial or industrial lands.

Dear Editor:

Re: Carbon Capture Farm proposal

The Carbon Capture Farm team thanks Leduc County and Thorsby residents for participating in three public engagement sessions over the past several weeks. We gathered valuable feedback and will report on everything we heard to Leduc County as part of the development permit application.

With community discussions and media coverage about the project, we want to ensure people who did not attend the information sessions understand the basics of the proposal.

The Carbon Capture Farm is an agriculture and recycling operation designed to reduce the amount of regional carbon emissions. This is achieved by manufacturing soil from organic waste, protecting the 110 acres of forested land on the selected quarter section and growing crops on the 40 acres of arable land.

The soil manufacturing component will be the most advanced facility of its kind in Alberta, using the latest composting best practices.

Many people have asked why we have chosen the quarter section on Range Road 10 northeast of Thorsby. We chose it because the site is nearly ideal for the following reasons:

- The quarter section (160 acres) allows us room to build the composting area in the middle of the property and have ample setbacks from neighbouring properties
- The site allows for an 8.5-acre composting area, which is five per cent of the total acreage and double the area at the Cleanit Greenit site in Edmonton's west end, for example. This allows for the material to be more spread out, reducing wind effects
- A major portion of the property – 110 acres – is still treed, allowing for a natural barrier
- Vegetated berms will be added on non-treed areas and facing the RR 10. The composting piles will be in line to the berm height and be no taller than four metres
- Our closest neighbours are an intensive livestock operation, Thorsby's sewage lagoon and a county waste-transfer station
- Prevailing wind is West-North-West, helping keep any fugitive smells away from more populated areas
- With 40 acres of already arable land around the composting area, the plan is to grow chemical-free barley for brewing (possibly an organic brewery developed at another site by the ownership group)

Another major theme we heard about is odour prevention. We have a team of six scientists supported by a team of five expert consultants to make sure leading technology is deployed at the site. We are building on 25 years of experience and have selected this site because of its many advantages to prevent odour and the space to implement best practices in composting.

Specifically, the site will use the following technologies and best-management practices to prevent odour:

- A rigorous aeration program, including pipes, blowers and excavators
- Biofiltration, which uses moist organic materials to stick to odorous compounds and break them down, which studies show is 80 to 98 per cent effective at stripping odours
- Composting piles with a lower profile than most sites (no more than four metres high) and tree and berm protection around the facility along with ample setbacks
- Strict inventory, process and housekeeping controls will be in place to help mitigate odour and present a clean, orderly appearance

Also, the site will house no more than 20,000 tonnes, which is 25 per cent less than the Cleanit Greenit site and conforms to draft Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP) regulations. The 25-per-cent reduction is due to increased throughput efficiencies.

As well, a thick clay liner and retention-pond system will protect Weed Creek.

In last week's letter we addressed several concerns brought up by the community, including wildlife and transportation. We are still conducting a traffic impact assessment, which will be presented to Leduc County as part of our application. We have a vested interest in road maintenance and safety and will do everything we can that is asked of us to keep the roads maintained and safe for everyone.

The Carbon Capture Farm represents a multi-million-dollar investment in Leduc County and the Thorsby area. We will hire local people for positions on-site and for contract hauling and other work. We are also eager to work with local communities on organics programs and contribute to the community through our composting fundraiser sales.

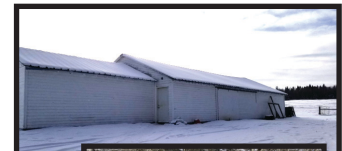

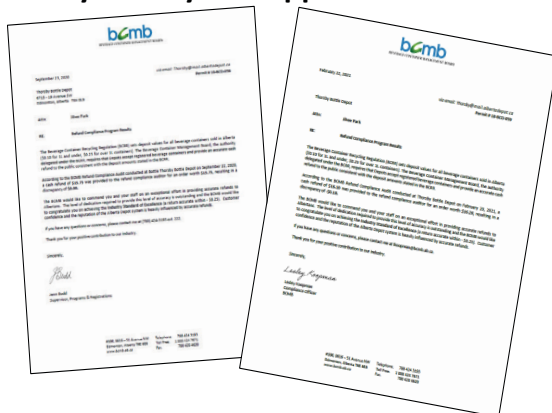

## MLA REPORT

from The Office of MLA Mark Smith,  
Member of the Legislative Assembly  
for Drayton Valley - Devon

Alberta's government has introduced two pieces of legislation as part of an ambitious democratic reform package that will strengthen democracy and accountability in Alberta. Bill 52, the Recall Act, would give Albertans the power to initiate a process that could potentially lead to the recall of provincial and municipal elected officials, and Bill 51, the Citizen Initiative Act, would allow Albertans to bring forward important matters to the legislature for consideration. Both pieces of legislation would help strengthen Albertans' roles in our democratic system.

If passed, Bill 52, the Recall Act, would allow Albertans to hold elected officials accountable and replace them if they aren't getting the representation they deserve. It would allow voters to remove elected officials from office, including MLAs, mayors, municipal councillors or school board trustees, providing them with one more tool to hold their elected representatives accountable. This builds on the accountability mechanisms that are currently in place, such as the Municipal Government Act which allows the Municipal Affairs minister to remove elected municipal officials from office under specific circumstances, and the Education Act which includes accountability measures for school board trustees.

If the Legislative Assembly of Alberta passes the Recall Act, Alberta will be the first province that provides the public with the power to initiate a process that could recall mayors, councillors or school board trustees from office. Under the proposed legislation, recall of elected officials becomes an option 18 months after their election. Any Albertan wishing to recall their elected official would need to contact the chief electoral officer, their municipality's chief administrative officer, or their school board secretary. They would then have 60 days to gather signatures from 40 per cent of the eligible voters for their provincial riding, municipal ward, or school ward, and if

successful, a recall vote would be held.

Bill 51, the Citizen Initiative Act, also gives Albertans a more direct role in their democratic system. This legislation would strengthen our democracy by enabling Albertans to initiate legislative action on issues that affect them. If enough support is received through a public petition, Albertans would be able to submit proposed bills and policies to the Legislative Assembly of Alberta for consideration and submit constitutional referendum questions to the provincial government. These proposed changes would complement the work of our elected officials and be a check and balance if Albertans feel their interests are not being considered.

Under this proposed legislation, if an Albertan wanted to bring an initiative forward, they would first need to apply to the Chief Electoral Officer. They would then have 90 days to gather signatures in support of their initiative. For legislative and policy initiatives, petitioners would need the support of 10 per cent of voters province-wide. For constitutional initiatives, they would require the support of 20 per cent of voters province-wide across two-thirds of Alberta's constituencies.

Democratic reform and recall legislation were election platform commitments. Both of these pieces of legislation represent promises made, and promises kept. The Citizen Initiative Act also builds upon Premier Jason Kenney's commitment to introduce citizen initiative legislation when discussing getting a 'fair deal for Alberta.'

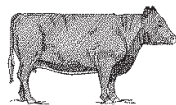
