Brazeau County Council Grants 30% Tax Rebate for 2021

BRAZEAU COUNTY, March 26, 2021 — At a special meeting March 23, Brazeau County Council passed a motion to again offer a 30% tax rebate to residential and commercial property owners.

Residential, farmland and commercial property owners who pay the full amount of their taxes by the due date will once again be eligible for a 30% rebate on their municipal taxes in 2021.

As the struggling oil and gas sector continues to create economic challenges for the families and individuals in the area, now compounded with the added financial strain that has come with the COVID-19 pandemic, Council voted to provide tax relief in the form of a 30% rebate on the municipal portion of taxes for residential and farmland property as well as a 30% rebate on the municipal portion of taxes for commercial businesses.

In order to be eligible to receive the rebate property owners must pay their current taxes and any tax arrears (unpaid tax amounts from previous years) in full by June 30, 2021. Tax and assessment notices that will be mailed in late May will not reflect the rebate amount in the total owing. The rebate will be applied at

time of payment, and property owners will be informed of their rebate amount via an insert in the tax and assessment notices.

"This will mark the sixth year Council has granted a municipal tax rebate to commercial businesses in Brazeau County and the second year the rebate has also been applied to residential and farmland properties," says Reeve Bart Guyon. "We believe strongly in leaving as much money as possible in taxpayers' pockets."

The 30% municipal tax rebate on residential and farmland property is in addition to a 30% reduction in the tax rate (also known as mill rate) that was introduced in 2015 and has been retained every year since then.

A reminder to residents that the 30% applies to the municipal portion of taxes only. Requisitions for the Alberta School Foundation Fund and Brazeau Seniors' Foundation are not subject to the rebate, but must be part of the full payment required by June 30.

As Information will be included in the tax and assessment notices outlining the rebate for eligible properties it is important for property owners to read all items included with their tax notices prior to submitting any payment.

Community Volunteer Income Tax Program - FREE INCOME TAX PREPERATION - For Low Income Persons, Families, seniors and students. We will begin taking information for tax season on March 1. Although this is something, that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2020 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families and students. If your income was in one of the following categories you may qualify for assistance.

1 person	30,000
2 person family	37,000
3 person family	40,500
4 person family	43,500

We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources:

Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1,000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30 – 4:00. Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 1 – April 30, 2021

We require the following information in order to complete your return:

Personal Information (Social Insurance Number, Birth date, Marital Status, Address)

Dependant's information – spouse/ children's names, birthdates.

All "T" Slips (T4's, T4A, OAS ect.)

All Forms, Schedules, and Labels you have received from Revenue Canada.

Receipts for any expenses such as medical, moving, tuition, sporting activities. Printouts from your pharmacist are available for those with numerous prescriptions.

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

Helping School-Age Children with Traumatic Grief: Tips for Caregivers

After an important person dies, children grieve in different ways. When the death was sudden or frightening, some children develop traumatic grief responses, making it hard for them to cope with their grief. Below are ways to recognize and help your child with traumatic grief.

	I WANT YOU TO KNOW THAT:	YOU CAN HELP ME WHEN YOU:
1.	My feelings about the death are confusing. Sometimes I feel okay, and other times I feel sad, scared, or just empty or numb. It's really hard to make the scary and sad feelings go away.	Talk about your feelings and encourage me to talk about mine as long as I feel comfortable.
2.	Sometimes my upset feelings come out as bad behavior.	Help me do things to feel calm, get back to my routine, and have fun again. Are patient until I feel O.K.
3.	I have trouble concentrating, paying attention, and sleeping sometimes, because what happened is on my mind.	 Understand that thoughts about what happened get stu in my mind. Help me relax at bedtime by reading stories or listening to music and reminding me that you keep n safe.
4.	I might have physical reactions like stomach aches, headaches, feeling my heart pounding, and breathing too fast.	Help me do things that make me feel calm, take my mir off things, or slow down my breathing.
5.	Sometimes I wonder if the death was my fault.	Reassure me that it was not my fault.
6.	I sometimes think the same thing will happen to me or other people I love.	 Remind me about the things we do to stay safe and tak care of ourselves. Help me remember all the people wh take care of me.
7.	I keep thinking about what happened over and over in my head.	Listen to what is on my mind. Tell me honestly what happened, using words I can understand. Do not let me see it on TV or other media if the story is in the news.
8.	Sometimes I don't like to think or talk about the person who died, because it's too hard. I may not tell you everything because I don't want to upset you.	Don't make me talk about what happened. Don't get m if I don't want to talk it or about the person.
9.	I don't like to go to some places or do some things that remind me of the person who died, or of how my life has changed since the person died, because I get upset.	Don't make me go places if it still makes me too upset scared.
10	. I have trouble remembering good things about the person because I remember other things that make me too mad, sad, or scared, and they get in the way.	Understand that I am still too scared and sad to think about the happy times right now. Help me to feel better

If any of these problems get in the way of your child having fun, going to school, being with friends, or doing other activities, you can make an appointment with your child to see a mental health professional with expertise in treating traumatized children.





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
