If you are an agricultural producer planning to haul grain or other agricultural commodities, you must get a permit if your load weights will be in excess of the restrictions.

Call RoaData at **1-888-444-9288** to obtain a road ban exemption permit for agriculture. Please call a minimum of 24 hours in advance of a planned move to ensure conditions allow for it.

2021 Dust Suppression Program

Application deadline: Saturday, May 15



Leduc County is currently accepting applications for our 2021 dust control program. There are two product choices available:

1. Calcium chloride

- Calcium chloride is a top shoot dust control product that is applied by spraying over the gravel surface.
- Two applications of the product will be done for every residence applying for this type of dust control. The second application will be automatically applied approximately six to eight weeks following the first application (weather permitting).
- Residents desiring a calcium chloride dust control product on the county road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and to prepay a fee of **\$374.50** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control requested beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged \$8.77 per metre.

2. Incorporated DL10

- Incorporated DL10 is a petroleum-based product that is applied to the road surface and mixed in and packed by graders.
- It is warrantied for one year from date of application.
- Residents desiring an incorporated dust control product on the county road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and to prepay a fee of **\$2,934.50** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged \$29.75 per metre.

Other information

- GST will be added to all prices listed above.
- The prices listed are after receiving a Leduc County subsidy of **\$695.50** per strip.
- This subsidy is provided to county residents living in permanent residences along a county gravel road.
- Businesses paying for residential strips will be charged the full rate without subsidy.
- The dust control program will begin as soon as possible after seasonal road bans have been lifted.
- Application forms are available from our Road Operations department at 1103 5 St. in Nisku or at **www.leduc-county.com/dust-suppression**.
- Applications with payment can be mailed to County Centre at 1101 5 St., Nisku, AB T9E 2X3 or delivered to our Services Building located at 1103 – 5th Street in Nisku.

We will build a raised 10' x 25' landscaped bed display around the flag poles using charcoal stacking stone at about a foot high. The landscaping will consist of shrubs and focus on perennials and annuals that display vibrant yellows as per the Hope Garden Campaign that is currently under way across Canada. We also wish to plant the vibrant Red Flanders Poppies along the sidewalk edges leading up to the cenotaph.

"The Thorsby Legion is excited to learn that your group is proposing to build a "Hope Garden" that would further enhance our Community Cenotaph that is located on the corner of 49 St and 49 Ave. in Thorsby. We feel your project aligns nicely with the grounds and will bring a beautiful display of colors from the yellows that are being proposed in the Hope Garden to the Poppies that will be planted along the sidewalk. By working together, we can achieve lasting, positive affects for the community to enjoy and continue to visit. We support your project and can't wait to see it completed.

Please accept our donation of \$5000.00 to be used towards the construction costs and plants required to complete this project. On behalf of the Thorsby Legion, we thank you for your ongoing work and dedication to our community."

The project will be completed over the summer of 2021.

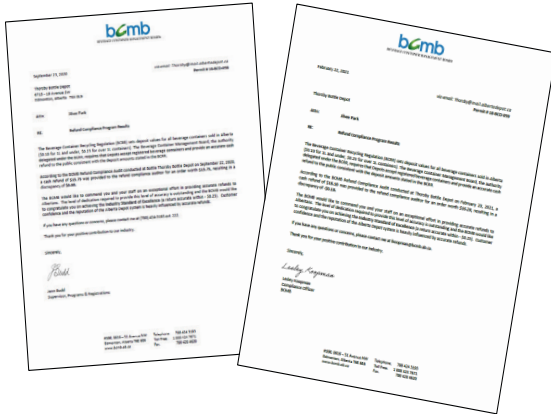

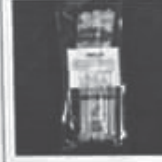

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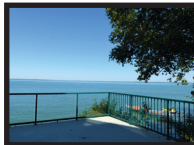
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Black Gold School Division Taking a Measured Approach to Alberta Education's Draft K-6 Curriculum

Nisku, Alberta (April 7, 2021) - After meeting this evening with the Board of Trustees, Black Gold School Division is planning a measured approach to examine our role in the Alberta Education's Draft Kindergarten -Grade 6 Curriculum validation (pilot) process.

The request to pilot the new draft Curriculum has not yet been made by Alberta Education. "Currently we are proactively engaging with our teaching and administrative staff, as well as our Trustees, to look critically into all aspects of the curriculum documents," said Superintendent of Schools Bill Romanchuk. "We have every confidence in our people, and we want them to provide meaningful feedback to Alberta Education."

"When the Division is asked to pilot all or part of the new Curriculum, ours will be a collaborative decision focussed on what's best for all students," said Superintendent Romanchuk. Concurrently, Black Gold parents/guardians are encouraged to review the new 2021 draft K-6 Curriculum at <https://curriculum.learnalberta.ca/curriculum/en> and provide feedback directly to the Alberta Government from the link found on that page.

Proposed Community Standards Bylaw

The proposed Community Standards Bylaw helps address unsightly premises in Leduc County. The purpose of the bylaw is to prevent unsightly premises from developing by outlining clear expectations and standards to citizens, and to provide an enforcement mechanism to address them when they occur.

The proposed bylaw applies to properties in hamlets, subdivisions and other identified areas. The proposed bylaw **does not** apply to agricultural, farming, commercial or industrial lands.

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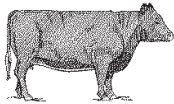

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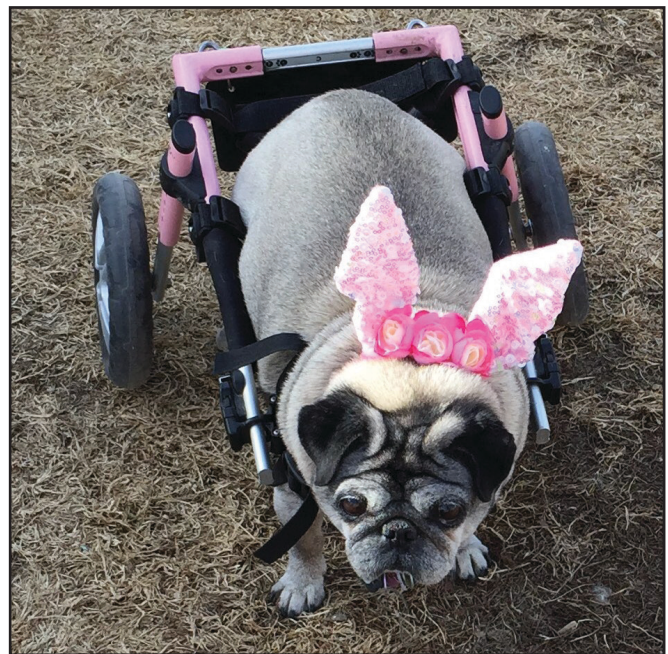
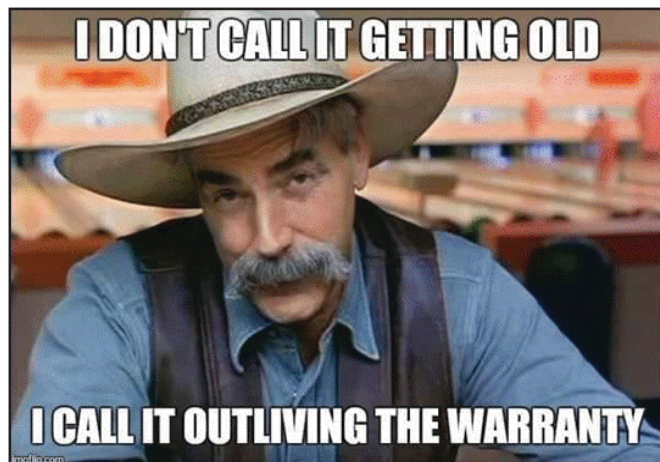
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Thorsby Healthy Communities Trail Development Survey
