Fire Restriction Issued For Leduc County

April 22, 2021 - Leduc County is now under a fire restriction as a result of dry conditions and to minimize our firefighters' risk of exposure to COVID-19. No open fires or fires in burn barrels are allowed and all open fires currently burning must be extinguished immediately.

All fire permits are suspended as per the Forest and Prairie Protection Act, and no fire permits will be issued for the duration of the restriction.

Citizens can use firepits and gas-fired (such as propane or natural gas) cooking and heating appliances such as barbecues, firepits and patio heaters, but should use extreme caution.

Fire officials will continue to monitor conditions, and will update the public at leduc-county.com and albertafirebans.ca when the restriction is lifted or downgraded, or a ban is issued.

Daughter Cathy joined Thorsby 4H Multi Club in 1980 and finished in Strawberry completing 10 years. All the while John was an active beef leader in both clubs for 11 years. Shirley never held a leadership role, but volunteered heavily. The original Thorsby Club banner was handmade by Shirley and she was involved in the making of the original Thorsby Club vests. Shirley and Cathy both judged public speaking at both Club and District levels.

In 1980 John and Shirley ventured into the purebred cattle business, J & S Herefords, raising Polled Herefords. They were always involved in many cattle shows including the 1998 Canadian Hereford Show held in Edmonton with approximately 700 head on display.

The Taylors promoted their cattle, the Hereford Breed and 4H with nothing but absolute pride for all their days in the livestock business.

This Club Calf will mark the last calf for sale from John and Shirley as they have dispersed their herd this year.



Proposed Community Standards Bylaw

The proposed Community Standards Bylaw helps address unsightly premises in Leduc County. The purpose of the bylaw is to prevent unsightly premises from developing by outlining clear expectations and standards to citizens, and to provide an enforcement mechanism to address them when they occur.

The proposed bylaw applies to properties in hamlets, subdivisions and other identified areas. The proposed bylaw **does not** apply to agricultural, farming, commercial or industrial lands.

2021 Dust Suppression Program

Application deadline: Saturday, May 15



Leduc County is currently accepting applications for our 2021 dust control program. There are two product choices available:

1. Calcium chloride

- Calcium chloride is a top shoot dust control product that is applied by spraying over the gravel surface.
- Two applications of the product will be done for every residence applying for this type of dust control. The second application will be automatically applied approximately six to eight weeks following the first application (weather permitting).
- Residents desiring a calcium chloride dust control product on the county road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and to prepay a fee of **\$374.50** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control requested beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged \$8.77 per metre.

2. Incorporated DL10

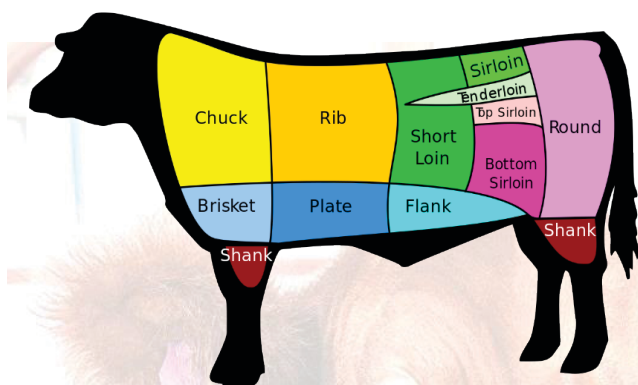
- Incorporated DL10 is a petroleum-based product that is applied to the road surface and mixed in and packed by graders.
- It is warrantied for one year from date of application.
- Residents desiring an incorporated dust control product on the county road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and to prepay a fee of **\$2,934.50** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged \$29.75 per metre.

Other information

- GST will be added to all prices listed above.
- The prices listed are after receiving a Leduc County subsidy of **\$695.50** per strip.
- This subsidy is provided to county residents living in permanent residences along a county gravel road.
- Businesses paying for residential strips will be charged the full rate without subsidy.
- The dust control program will begin as soon as possible after seasonal road bans have been lifted.
- Application forms are available from our Road Operations department at 1103 5 St. in Nisku or at **www.leduc-county.com/dust-suppression**.
- Applications with payment can be mailed to County Centre at 1101 5 St., Nisku, AB T9E 2X3 or delivered to our Services Building located at 1103 – 5th Street in Nisku.

EXCUSE ME

Say this gently and firmly. This lets your child know that they have crossed the line. It also does not invite more back talk.



YOU SOUND UPSET AND ANGRY

Responding with empathy helps kids feel less threatened and has the power to stop power struggles in their tracks.



REWIND, LET'S TRY AGAIN

A simple, gentle way to let your child know that they are behaving badly. Using the word, "Let's" shows them that you are on the same team. The underlying message is, "we can work through this and stay calm together..."



TAKE A DEEP BREATH..

Taking a deep breath physiologically helps you calm down. If you do this often, it can become a signal to kids that you are upset and a hint that they should start toeing the line. Sometimes you might not even need to say anything else.



CAN YOU SAY THAT RESPECTFULLY?

This should be said when you are calm. The underlying message is one of faith, "I know you can improve your behavior and be respectful..."

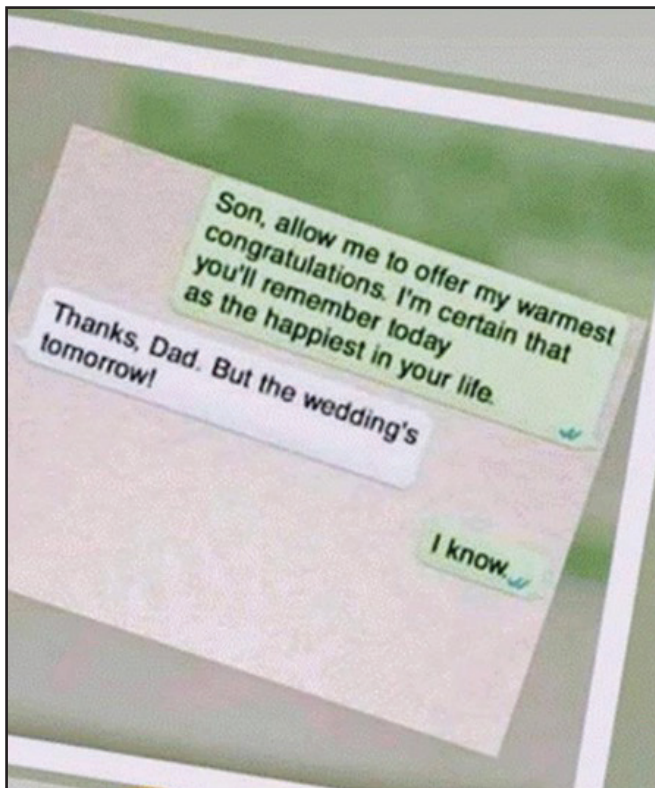
