## Restrictions Eased in Continuing Care Facilities

Since the beginning of the pandemic, seniors and residents in continuing care facilities have shouldered a uniquely heavy burden and sacrificed precious time with their loved ones.

These are parents, grandparents, and friends who need the hope, joy, and connection that many of us took for granted before the arrival of the virus.

Despite being vulnerable, Alberta's government understand that those living in continuing care are some of our strongest citizens with the most important stories to tell. When the pandemic began, we swiftly brought in public health rules to protect these Albertans. And we ensured they were a top priority in our vaccine rollout. Now, with 100 per cent of these Albertans having been offered a vaccine, we can safely begin to ease restrictions in continuing care facilities across the province.

Thanks to high rates of vaccination among residents and staff at continuing care facilities, updated public health measures will come into effect starting May 10 to allow families to more easily visit their loved ones. These updates will increase the number of designated family or support persons for each resident, expand the number of people who can attend outdoor social visits, and allow limited indoor social gatherings. Changes to visitation policy are not mandatory and will vary by site based on different factors, including the design of the building and the wishes of the residents.

Where possible, and provided the majority of residents agree, indoor social visits with up to four visitors will resume again. Visitors must be from the same household and adhere to the masking and distancing requirements that remain in place.

Outdoor social visits at continuing care facilities can expand up to ten people, including the resident. This is double the current limit of five and brings the limit in-line with the current outdoor limit for the rest of Alberta.

Residents may name up to four designated family or support persons for unrestricted access, and visitors will continue to be able to visit when residents are approaching the end of their lives or suffer a change in health status.

Alberta's government has updated these public health measures based on the feedback we received from those most impacted. Throughout April, town halls were held with continuing care operators, residents and staff to discuss the impact of getting Albertans vaccinated and COVID-19 variants. The majority of participants said they were ready for eased restrictions but wanted some safety measures to remain.

As we keep moving forward, Alberta's government will continue to monitor the emerging evidence on vaccines and their ability to protect residents from the variants and limit transmitting the virus to others. The updated measures coming into effect on May 10 strike the right balance between protecting residents and staff from COVID-19 and enabling a strong quality of life.

We are starting to see signs of a return to normal, and while we all must remain vigilant in the fight against COVID-19, we should do what we can to connect with our loved ones in continuing care and share those precious moments we all need.

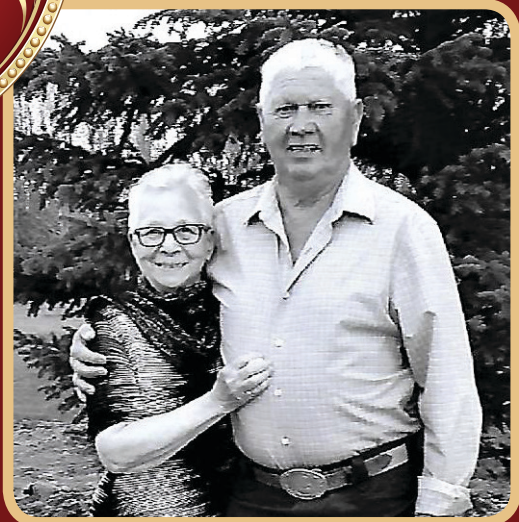

## Household Hazardous Waste



These solid or liquid materials and gas containers have outlived their usefulness and could harm people or the environment, without special handling and treatment in how they are discarded. They can be flammable, corrosive, explosive or toxic and because of these dangerous characteristics should not be sent to the landfill or emptied into sewer systems. Household hazardous products in Canada display one or more of the following symbols:

- **Flammable** - burn easily (painting wastes, degreasers, and other solvents).
- **Corrosive** - eat away surfaces and skin (rust removers, alkaline cleaning fluids and old batteries).
- **Reactive/Explosive** - react violently when mixed with other chemicals, under pressure or heat (aerosols).
- **Toxic/Poison** - poison or cause damage to living organisms (materials containing heavy metals like mercury, lead or cadmium).

When a product displaying one or more of the warning symbols is discarded (after considering reuse possibilities), it should be disposed of properly. Examples of acceptable products below.

## Household Hazardous Waste



These solid or liquid materials and gas containers have outlived their usefulness and could harm people or the environment, without special handling and treatment in how they are discarded. They can be flammable, corrosive, explosive or toxic and because of these dangerous characteristics should not be sent to the landfill or emptied into sewer systems. Household hazardous products in Canada display one or more of the following symbols:

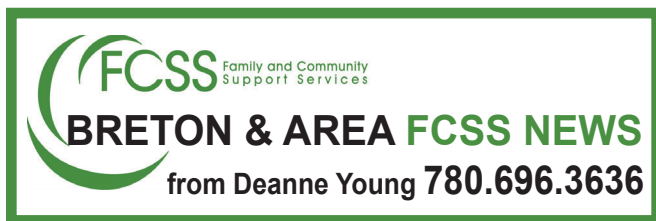
- **Flammable** - burn easily (painting wastes, degreasers, and other solvents).
- **Corrosive** - eat away surfaces and skin (rust removers, alkaline cleaning fluids and old batteries).
- **Reactive/Explosive** - react violently when mixed with other chemicals, under pressure or heat (aerosols).
- **Toxic/Poison** - poison or cause damage to living organisms (materials containing heavy metals like mercury, lead or cadmium).

When a product displaying one or more of the warning symbols is discarded (after considering reuse possibilities), it should be disposed of properly. Examples of acceptable products below.

A subsidy is available for individuals, couples and/or families who are struggling with common, everyday issues to access short-term preventative counselling services. The goal is to:

Latimer wrote Ridley once that when he was settled and steadfast about his own salvation he was as bold as a lion, but if that hope became eclipsed he was fearful and afraid and was disqualified for service. Many are disqualified for service because they are continually doubting their own salvation. Are you sure of your salvation?

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Acts 2:38.
