

Thorsby RCMP Arrest Two Males For Break And Enter And Theft Of ATM

Thorsby, Alta. – May 13, 2021 - After a lengthy investigation conducted by the Thorsby/Breton RCMP, two males have been arrested in relation to several reported break and enters in the Town of Thorsby, Alta.

On October 6, 2019, Thorsby RCMP responded to multiple break and enters including the theft of an ATM from the Esso fuel station in Thorsby. Police also investigated an attempted theft of an ATM from the Thorsby Village Supermarket.

On March 19, 2021, one male (30) of Edmonton, Alta. was arrested and charged with:

Theft of Truck (x2)

Mischief over \$5000 (x3)

Break and enter (x3)

Possession of break in tools (x3)

Wear a disguise committing an offence

Possession of stolen property

He has been released from custody and is scheduled to appear in Breton Provincial Court on May 26, 2021.

On April 30, 2021, an additional male (32) of Edmonton, Alta. was arrested and charged with:

Theft of Truck (x2)

Mischief over \$5000 (x3)

Break and enter (x3)

Possession of break in tools (x3)

Wear a disguise committing an offence

Possession of stolen property

Operate motor vehicle while prohibited

He remains in custody and is scheduled to appear in Breton Provincial Court on May 26, 2021.

"As a result of these arrests several outstanding files have now been brought before the courts," said S/Sqt. Dwayne Moore, Thorsby RCMP Detachment Commander. "We will continue to strategically focus on property crime offenders in keeping with our crime reduction strategies."

Application summary:

The Alberta Utilities Commission expects to receive an application from ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. to renew its franchise agreement with the Town of Thorsby, following the submission deadline indicated below.

The franchise agreement will continue to allow ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. the exclusive right to deliver natural gas to the residents of the Town of Thorsby for 10 years effective October 1, 2021.

The monthly franchise fee percentage will *remain the same at* 20 per cent effective October 1, 2021. Including linear property taxes, the franchise fee for an average residential customer is forecast to *remain at* \$12.29 per month. An average residential customer uses about 115 gigajoules per year.




